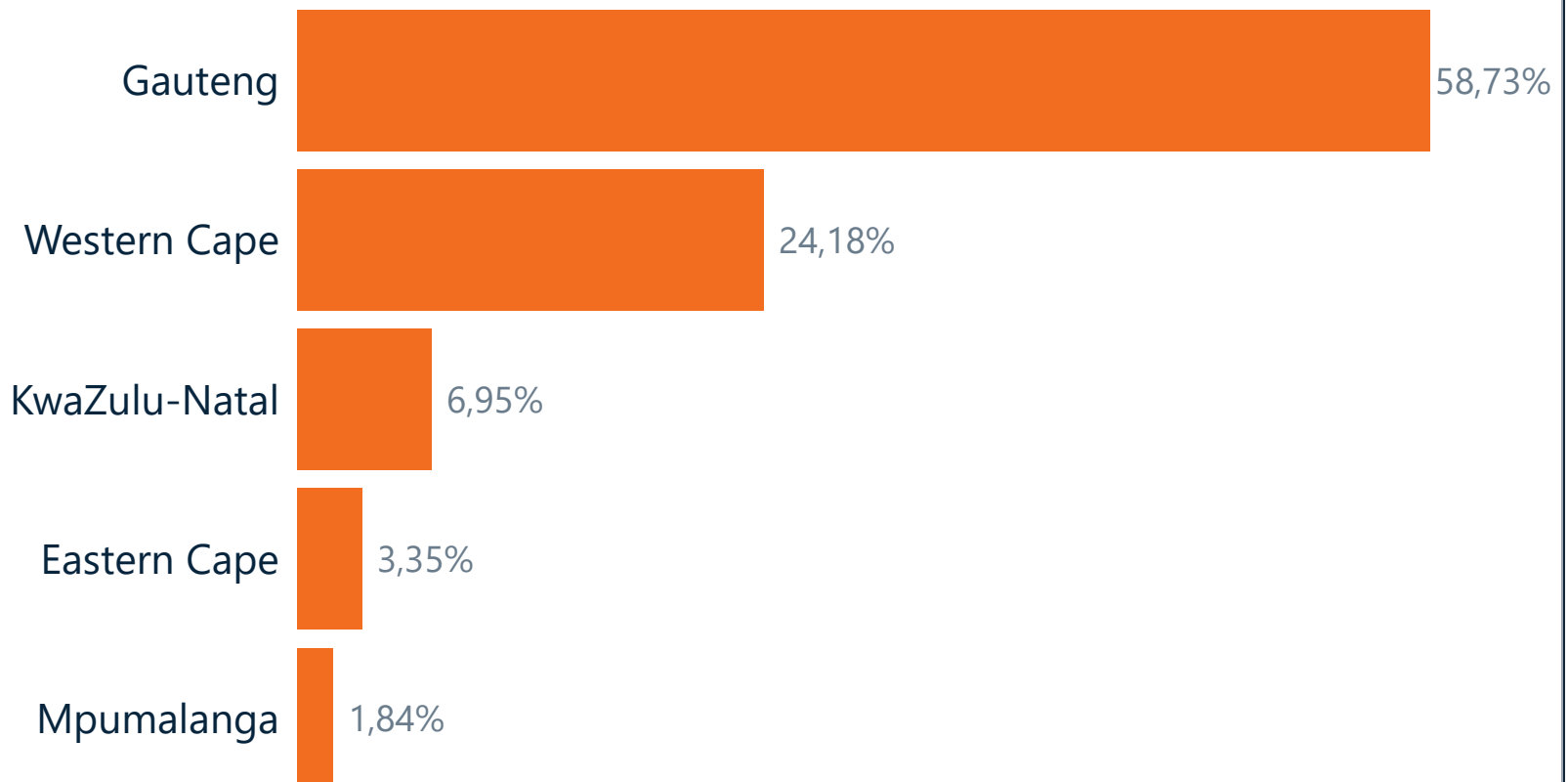

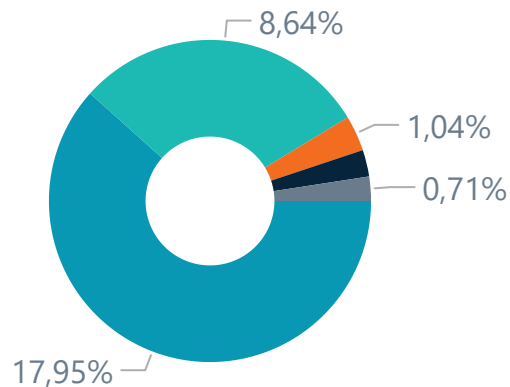

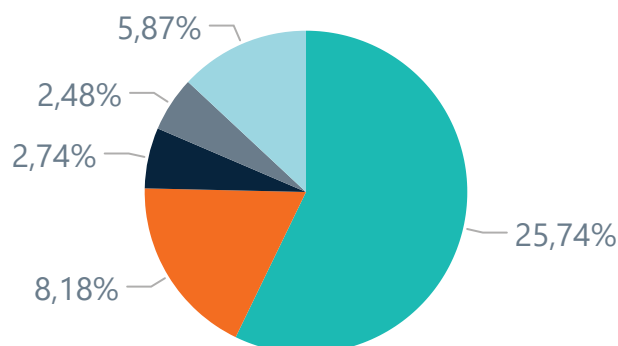

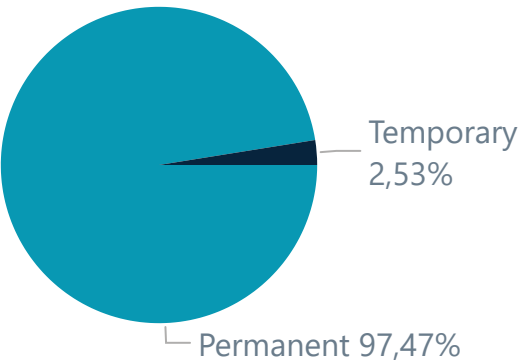

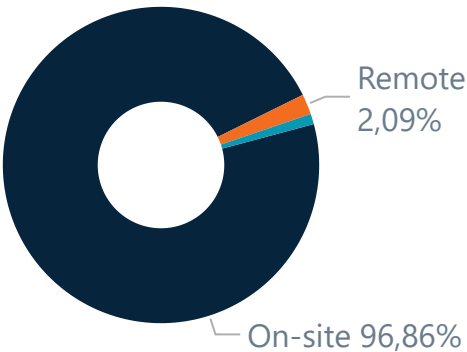
Employment Type

percentage of job opportunities



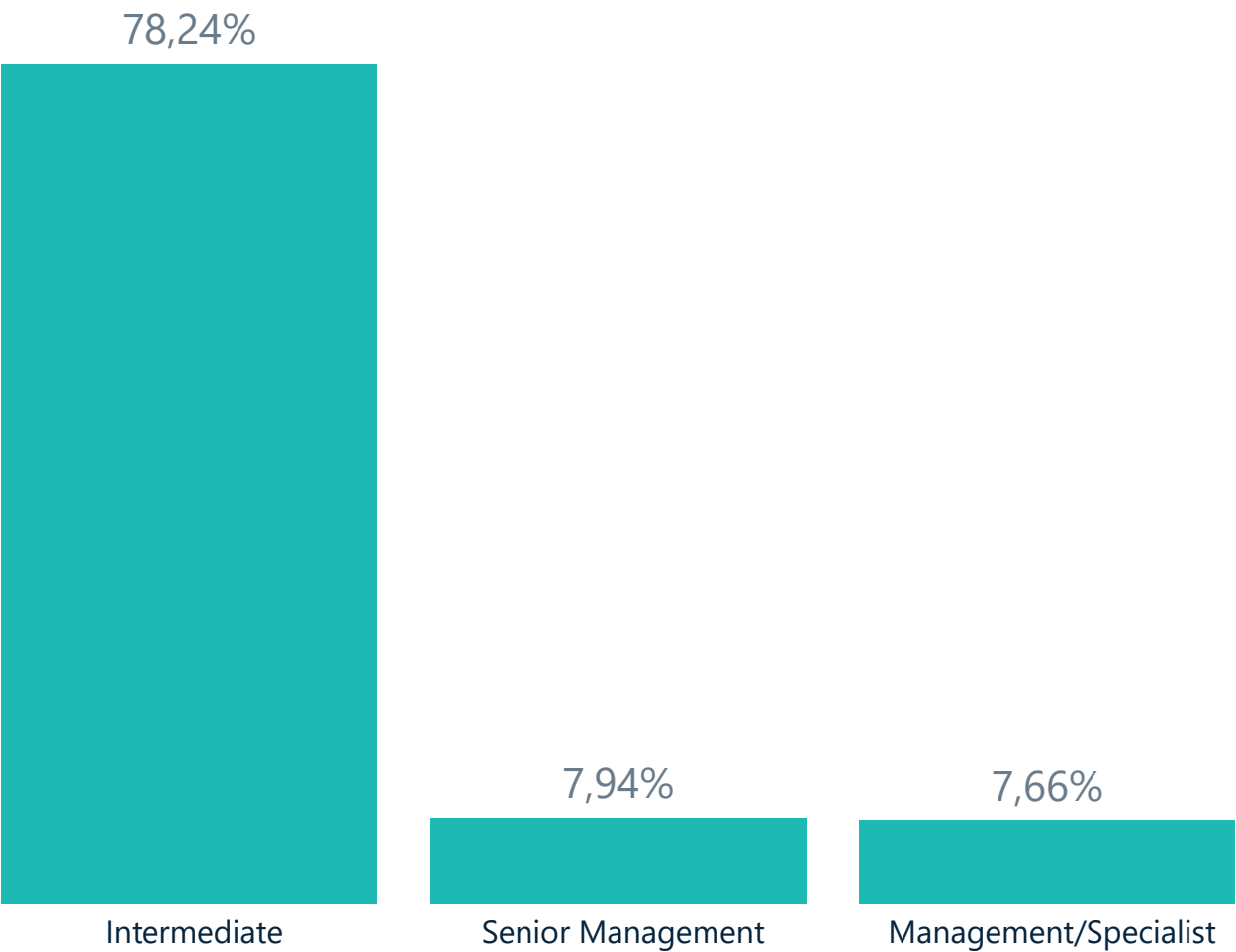
Employment Flexibility

by percentage of job opportunities

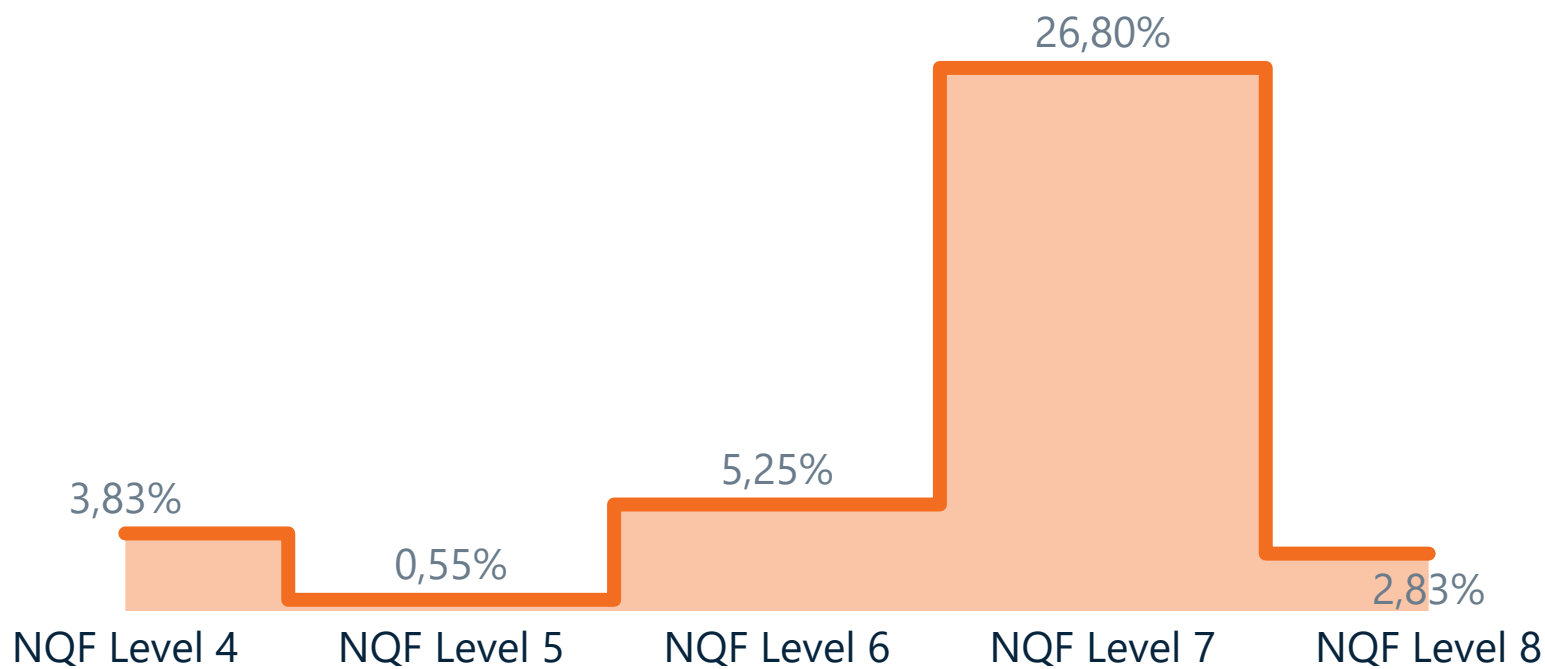

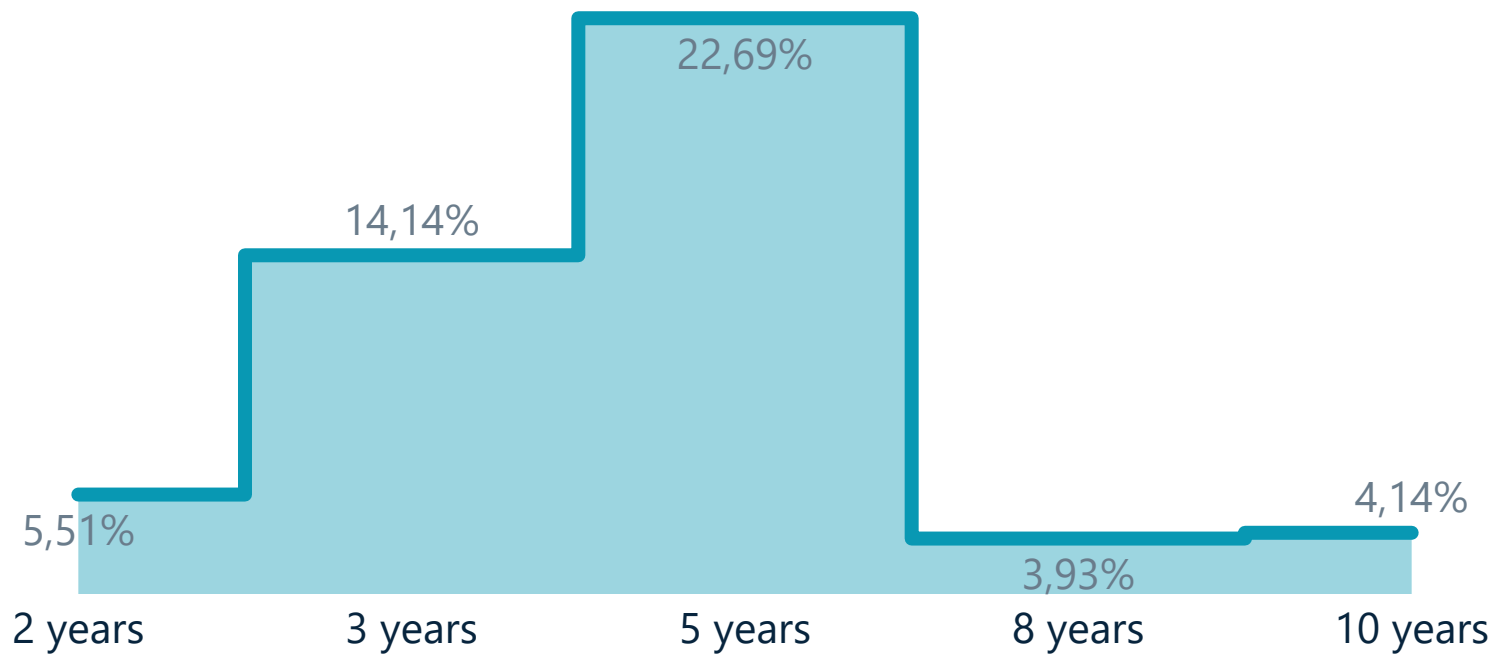
Top 5 Minimum Qualification Level

Top 10 Required Skills

Time Management	
Managing one's own time and the time of others.	1
Management of Financial Resources	
Determining how money will be spent to get the work done, and accounting for these expenditures.	2
Service Orientation	
Actively looking for ways to help people.	3
Learning Strategies	
Selecting and using training/instructional methods and procedures appropriate for the situation when learning or teaching new things.	4
Systems Analysis	
Determining how a system should work and how changes in conditions, operations, and the environment will affect outcomes.	5
Writing	
Communicating effectively in writing as appropriate for the needs of the audience.	6
Complex Problem Solving	
Identifying complex problems and reviewing related information to develop and evaluate options and implement solutions.	7
Negotiation	
Bringing others together and trying to reconcile differences.	8
Operations Analysis	
Analyzing needs and product requirements to create a design.	9
Coordination	
Adjusting actions in relation to others' actions.	10

Top 5 Required Knowledge

Administration and Management	
Business and management principles involved in strategic planning, resource allocation, human resources modeling, leadership technique, production methods, and coordination of people and resources.	1
Customer and Personal Service	
Principles and processes for providing customer and personal services. This includes customer needs assessment, meeting quality standards for services, and evaluation of customer satisfaction.	2
Communications and Media	
Media production, communication, and dissemination techniques and methods. This includes alternative ways to inform and entertain via written, oral, and visual media.	3
Economics and Accounting	
Economic and accounting principles and practices, the financial markets, banking, and the analysis and reporting of financial data.	4
Sales and Marketing	
Principles and methods for showing, promoting, and selling products or services. This includes marketing strategy and tactics, product demonstration, sales techniques, and sales control systems.	5
