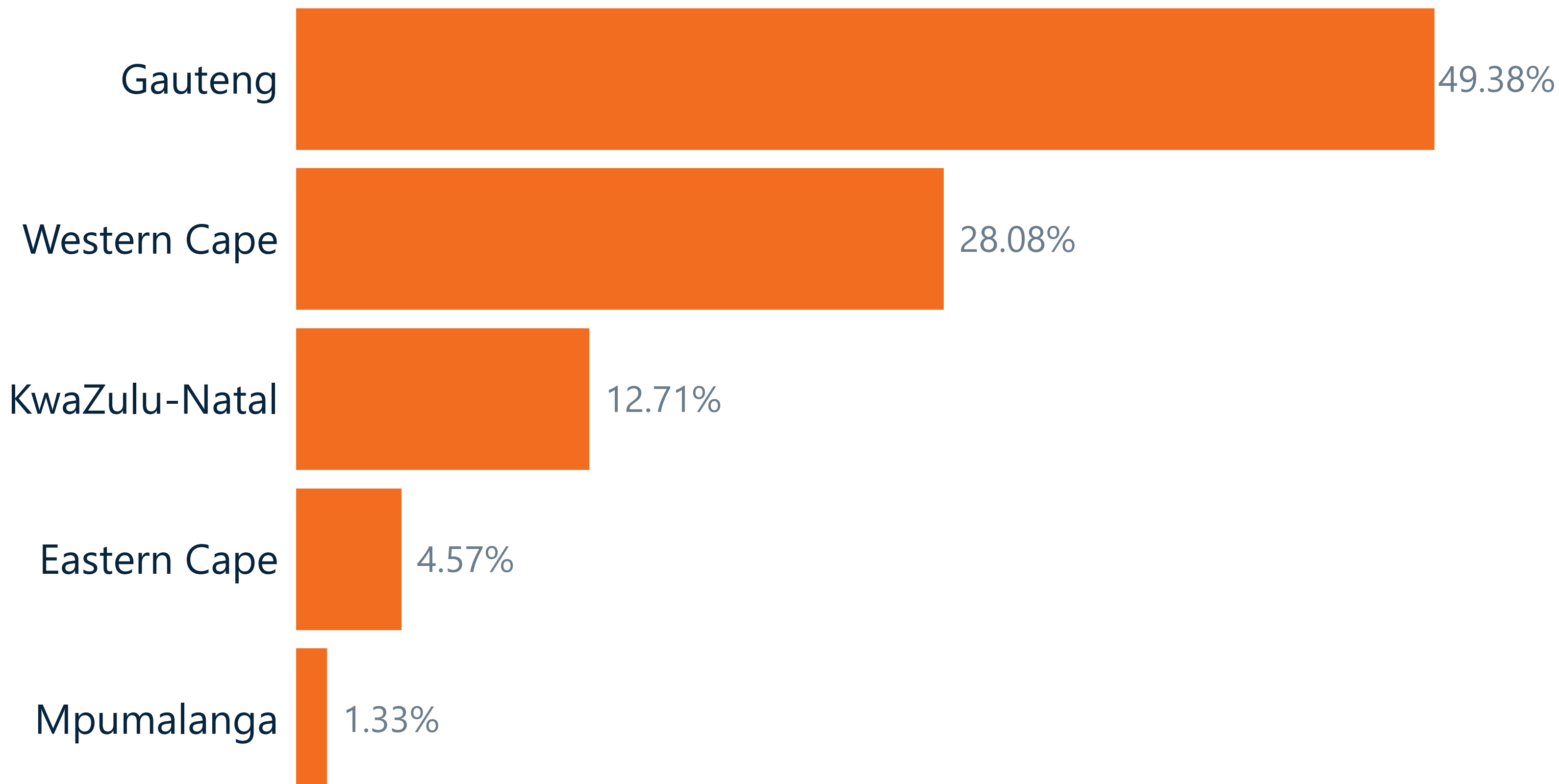

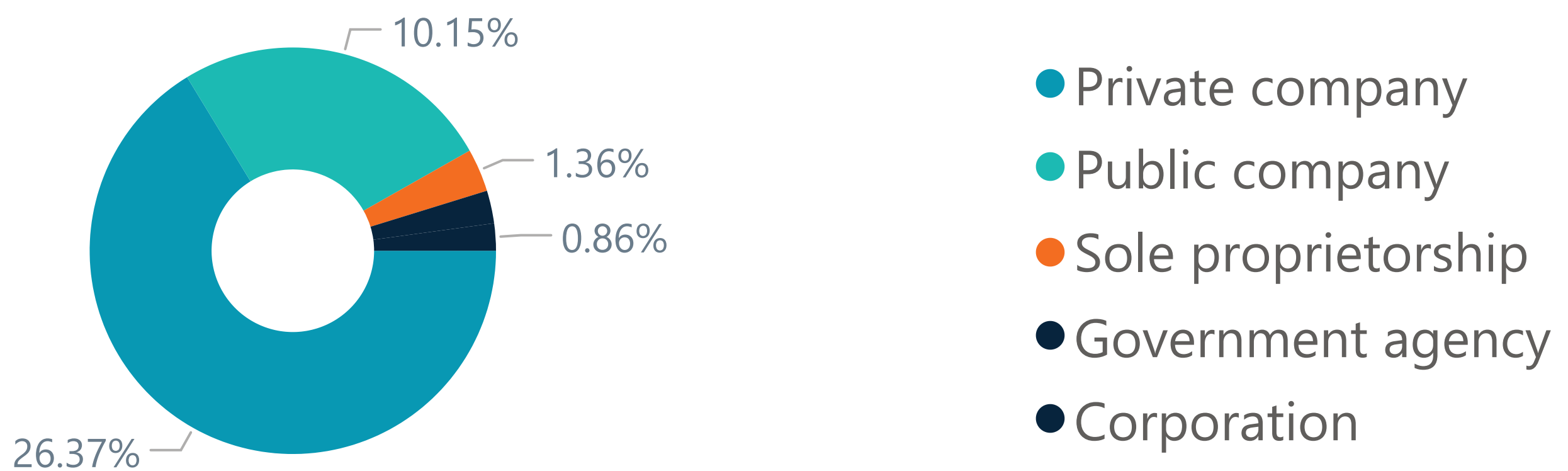
## Top 5 Industries

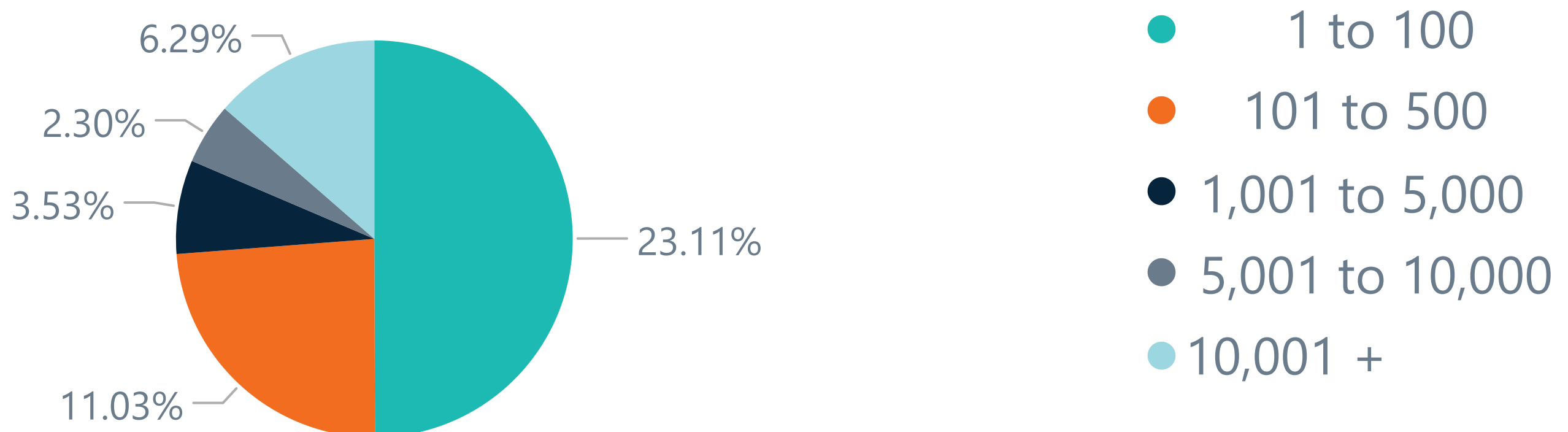
## Top 5 Company Types

## Top 5 Company Sizes

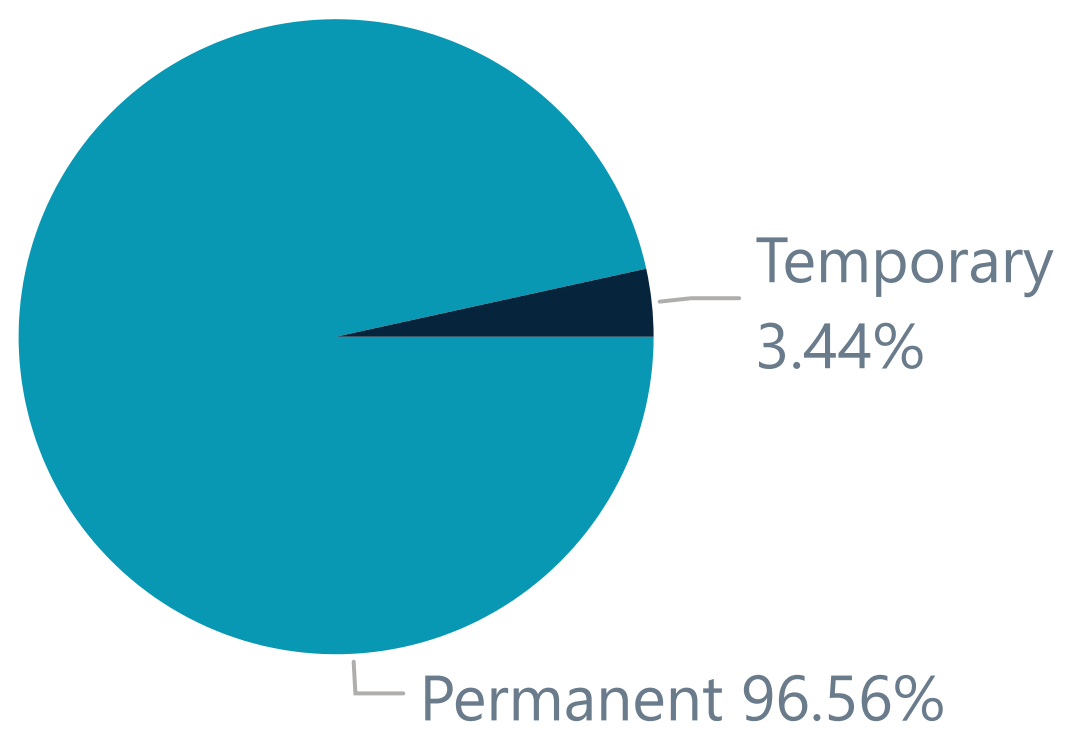

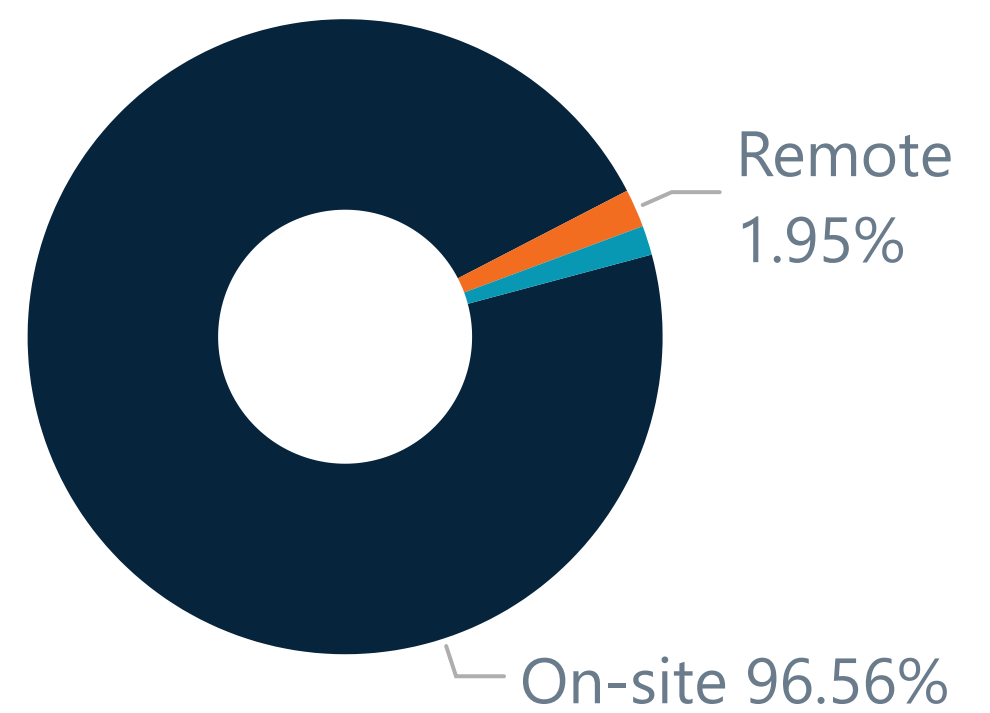
## Employment Type

percentage of job opportunities



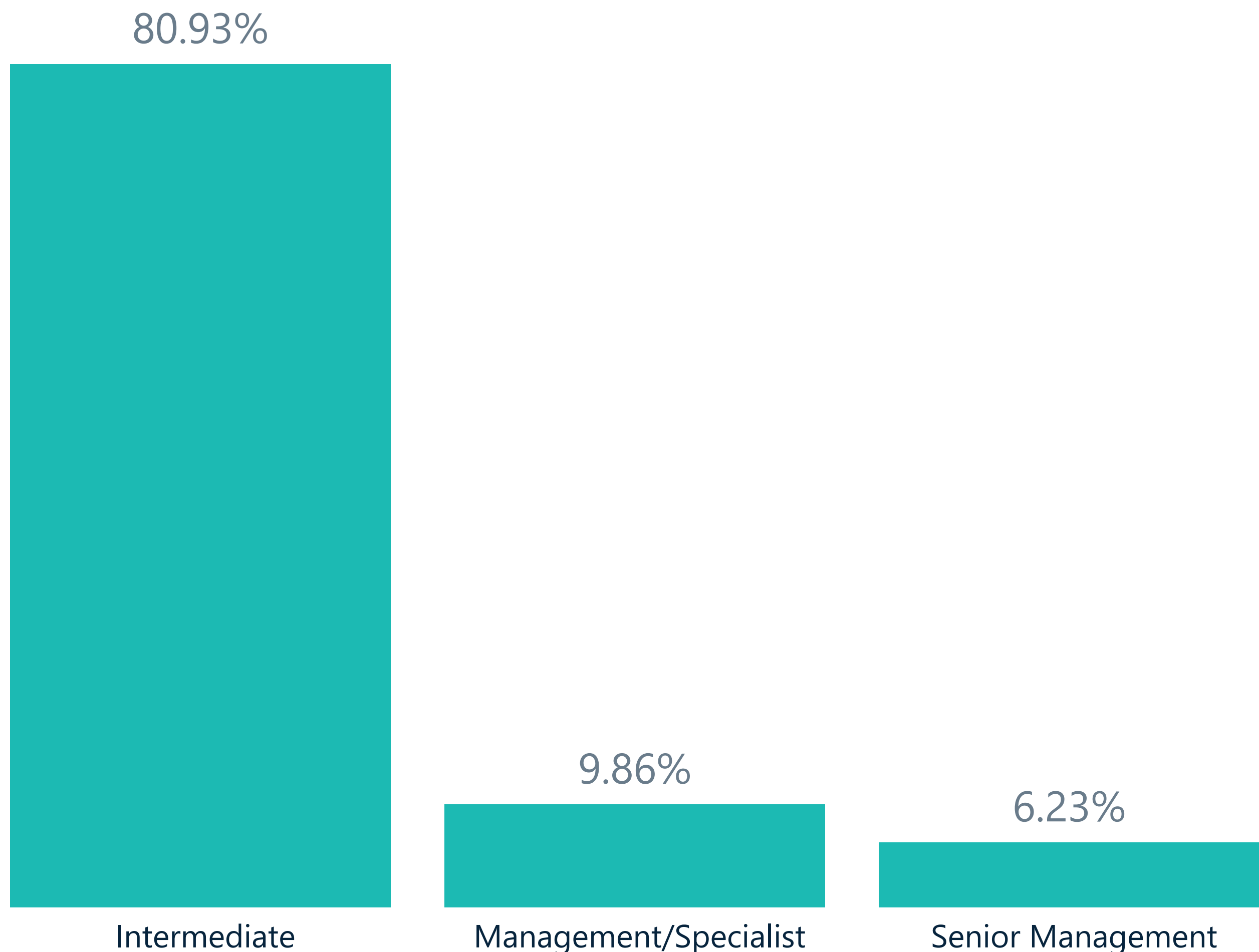
## Employment Flexibility

## Top 3 Employment Levels

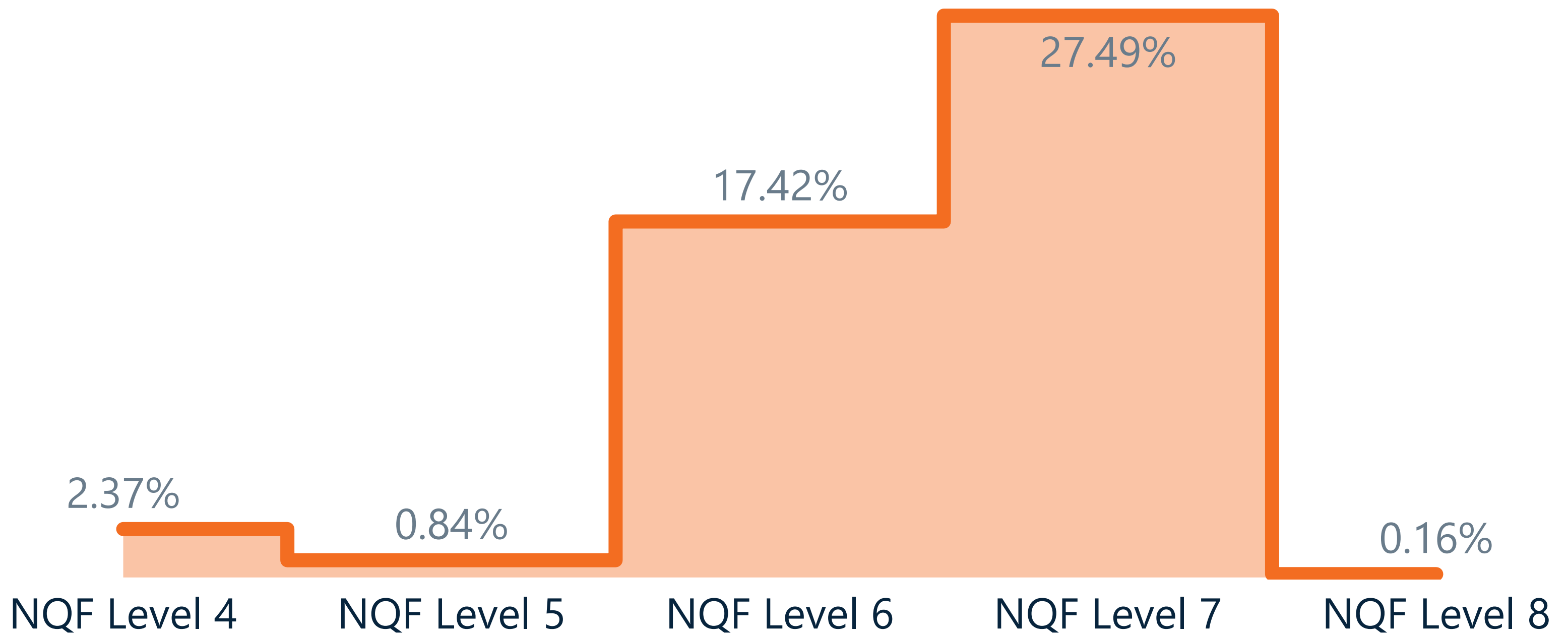

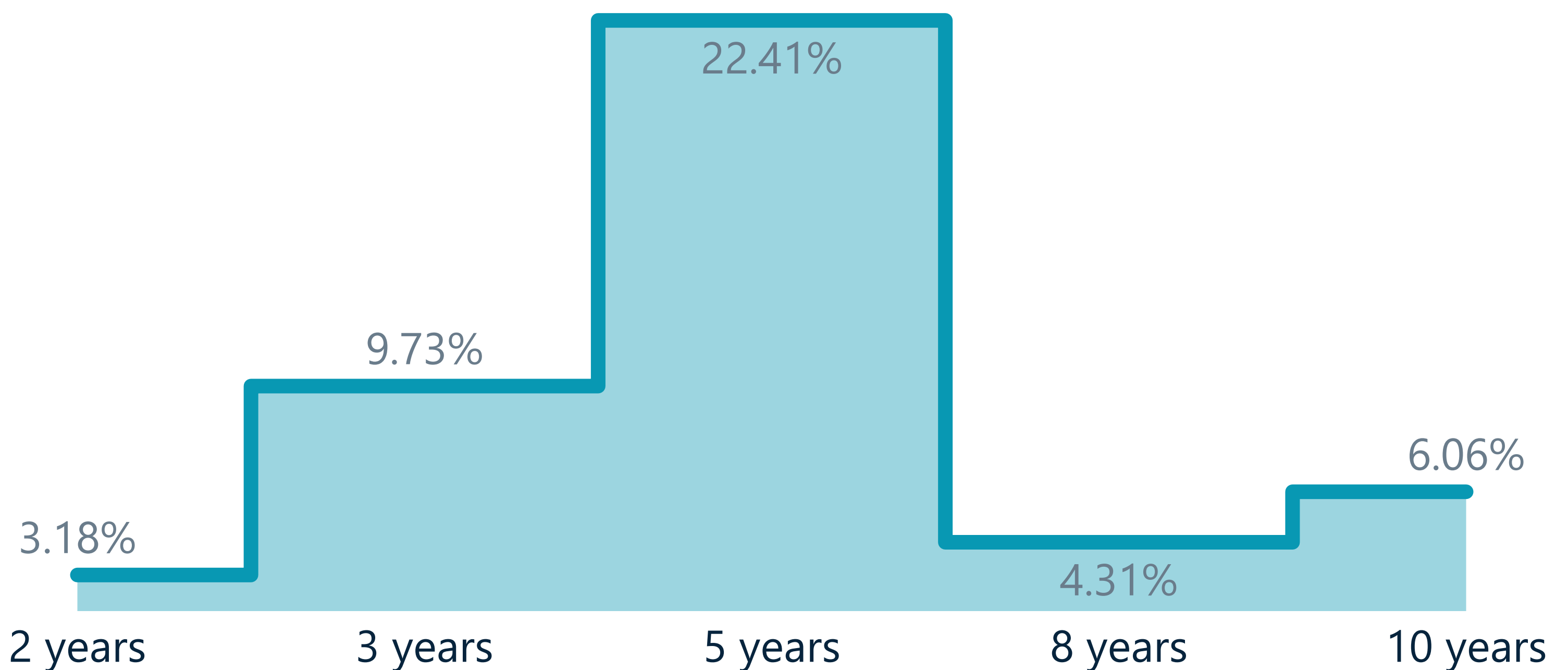
## Top 5 Minimum Qualification Level

## Top 10 Required Skills

<b>Time Management</b>	
Managing one's own time and the time of others.	<b>1</b>
<b>Service Orientation</b>	
Actively looking for ways to help people.	<b>2</b>
<b>Systems Analysis</b>	
Determining how a system should work and how changes in conditions, operations, and the environment will affect outcomes.	<b>3</b>
<b>Learning Strategies</b>	
Selecting and using training/instructional methods and procedures appropriate for the situation when learning or teaching new things.	<b>4</b>
<b>Writing</b>	
Communicating effectively in writing as appropriate for the needs of the audience.	<b>5</b>
<b>Complex Problem Solving</b>	
Identifying complex problems and reviewing related information to develop and evaluate options and implement solutions.	<b>6</b>
<b>Management of Material Resources</b>	
Obtaining and seeing to the appropriate use of equipment, facilities, and materials needed to do certain work.	<b>7</b>
<b>Negotiation</b>	
Bringing others together and trying to reconcile differences.	<b>8</b>
<b>Operations Analysis</b>	
Analyzing needs and product requirements to create a design.	<b>9</b>
<b>Coordination</b>	
Adjusting actions in relation to others' actions.	<b>10</b>

## Top 5 Required Knowledge

### Administration and Management

Business and management principles involved in strategic planning, resource allocation, human resources modeling, leadership technique, production methods, and coordination of people and resources.

### Customer and Personal Service

Principles and processes for providing customer and personal services. This includes customer needs assessment, meeting quality standards for services, and evaluation of customer satisfaction.

### Communications and Media

Media production, communication, and dissemination techniques and methods. This includes alternative ways to inform and entertain via written, oral, and visual media.

### Public Safety and Security

Relevant equipment, policies, procedures, and strategies to promote effective local, state, or national security operations for the protection of people, data, property, and institutions.

### Personnel and Human Resources

Principles and procedures for personnel recruitment, selection, training, compensation and benefits, labor relations and negotiation, and personnel information systems.
