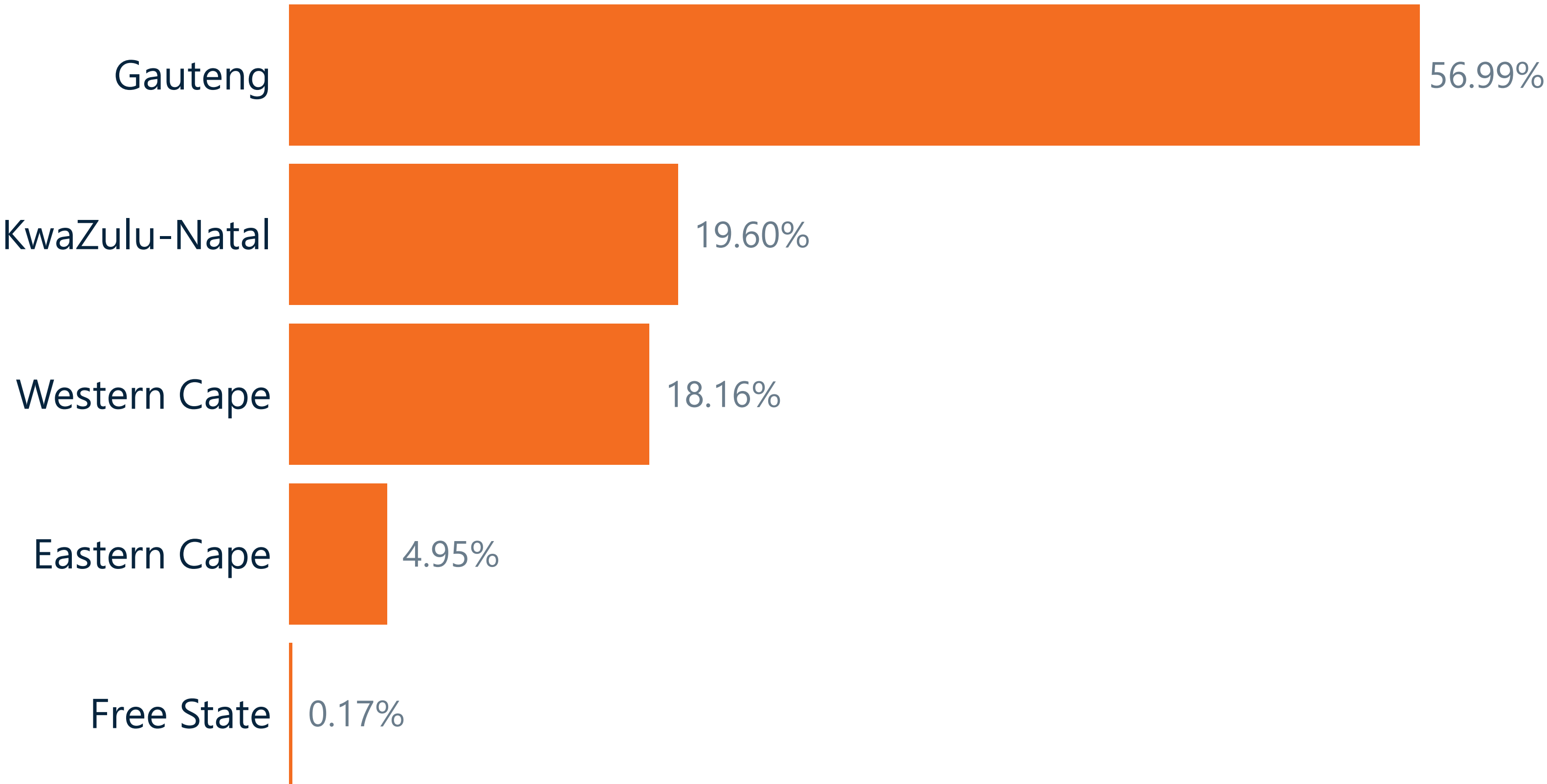

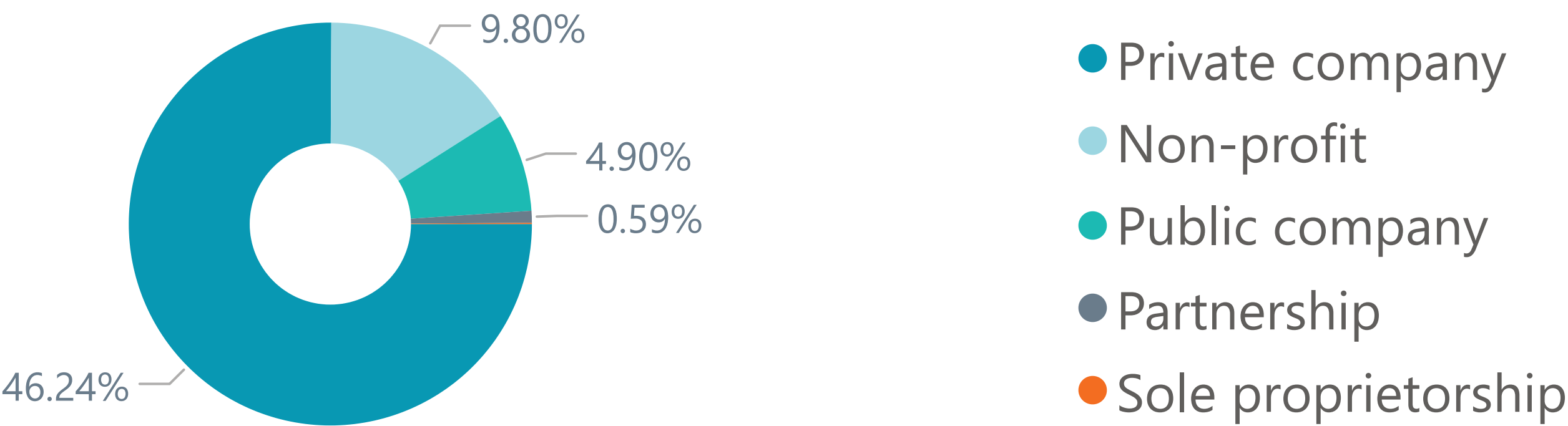

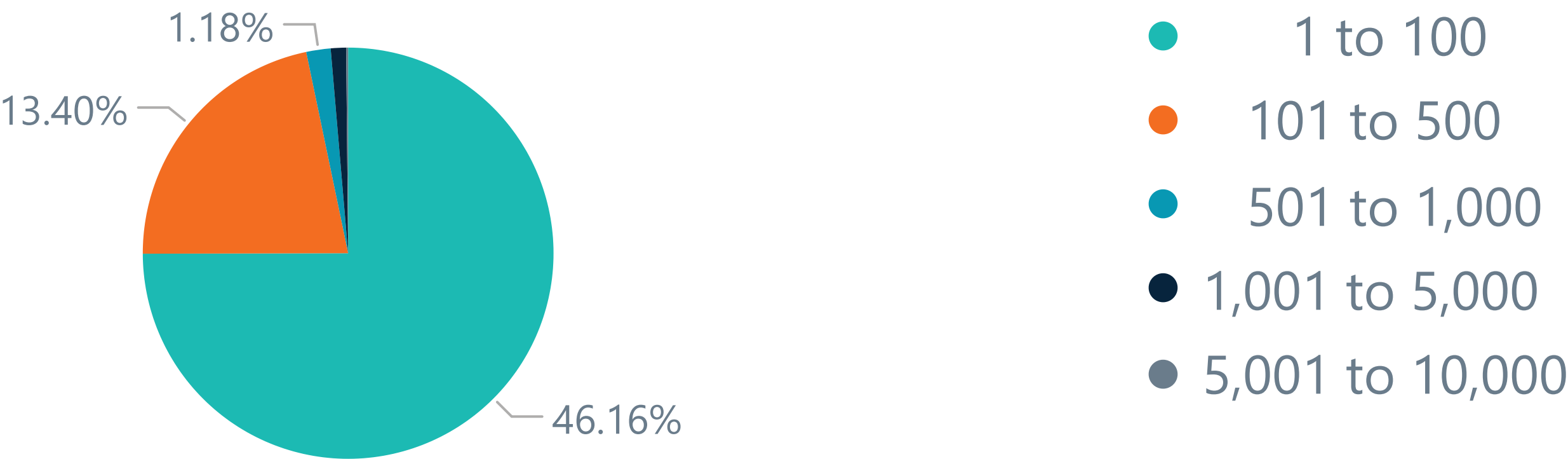
Top 5 Company Types

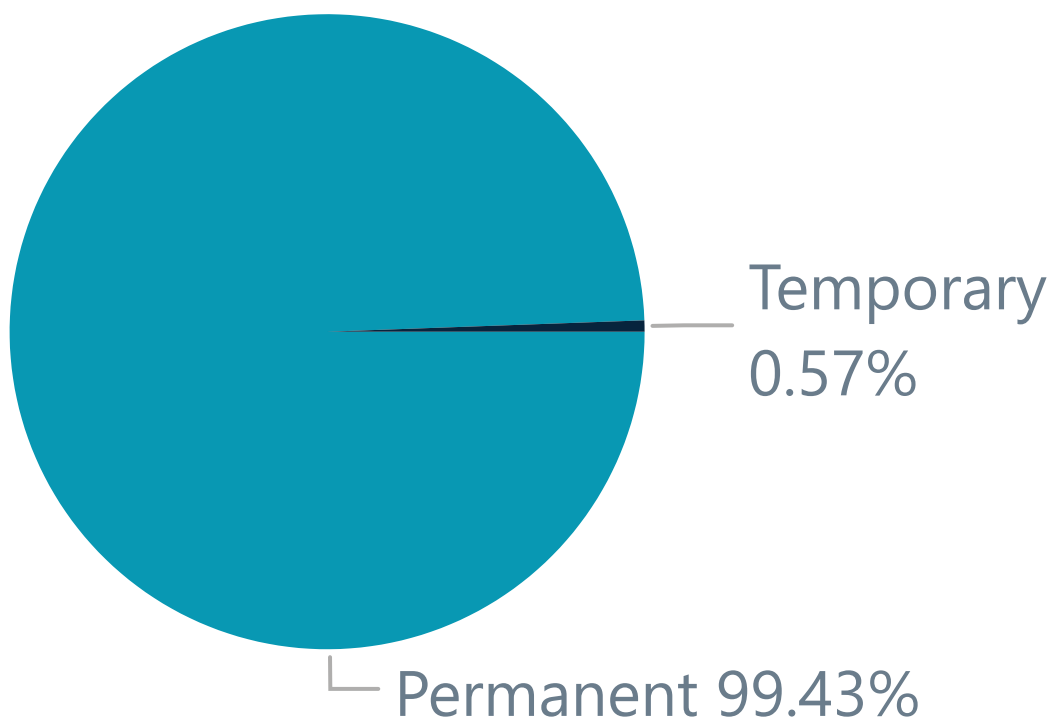




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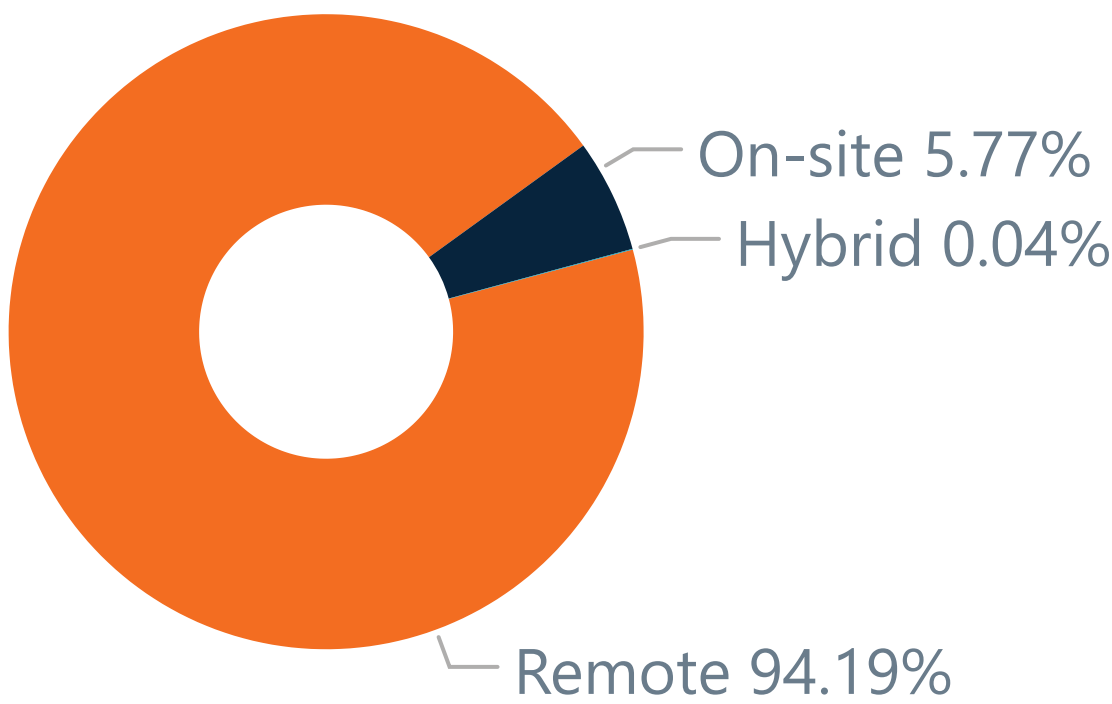
Employment Type

percentage of job opportunities



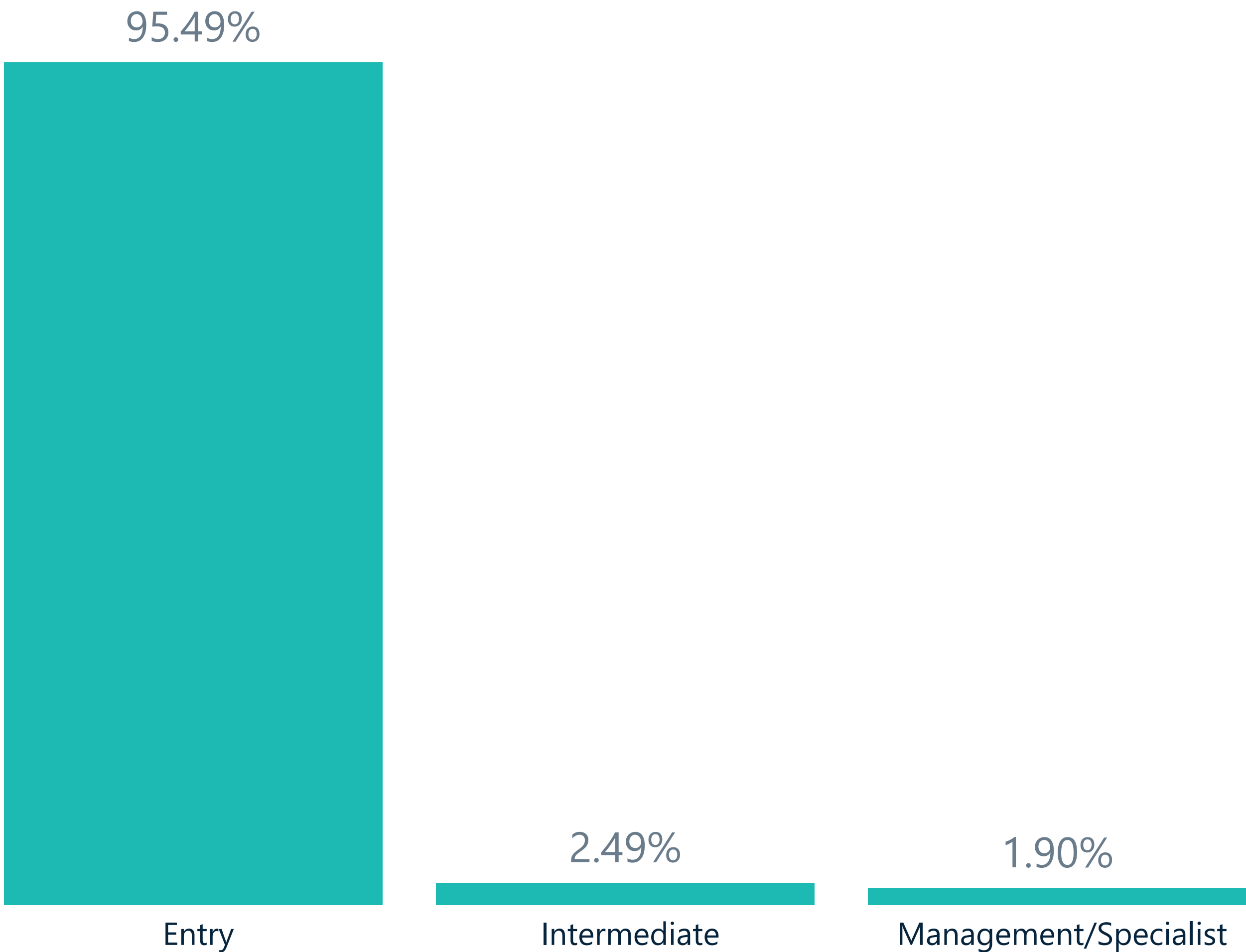
Employment Flexibility

by percentage of job opportunities



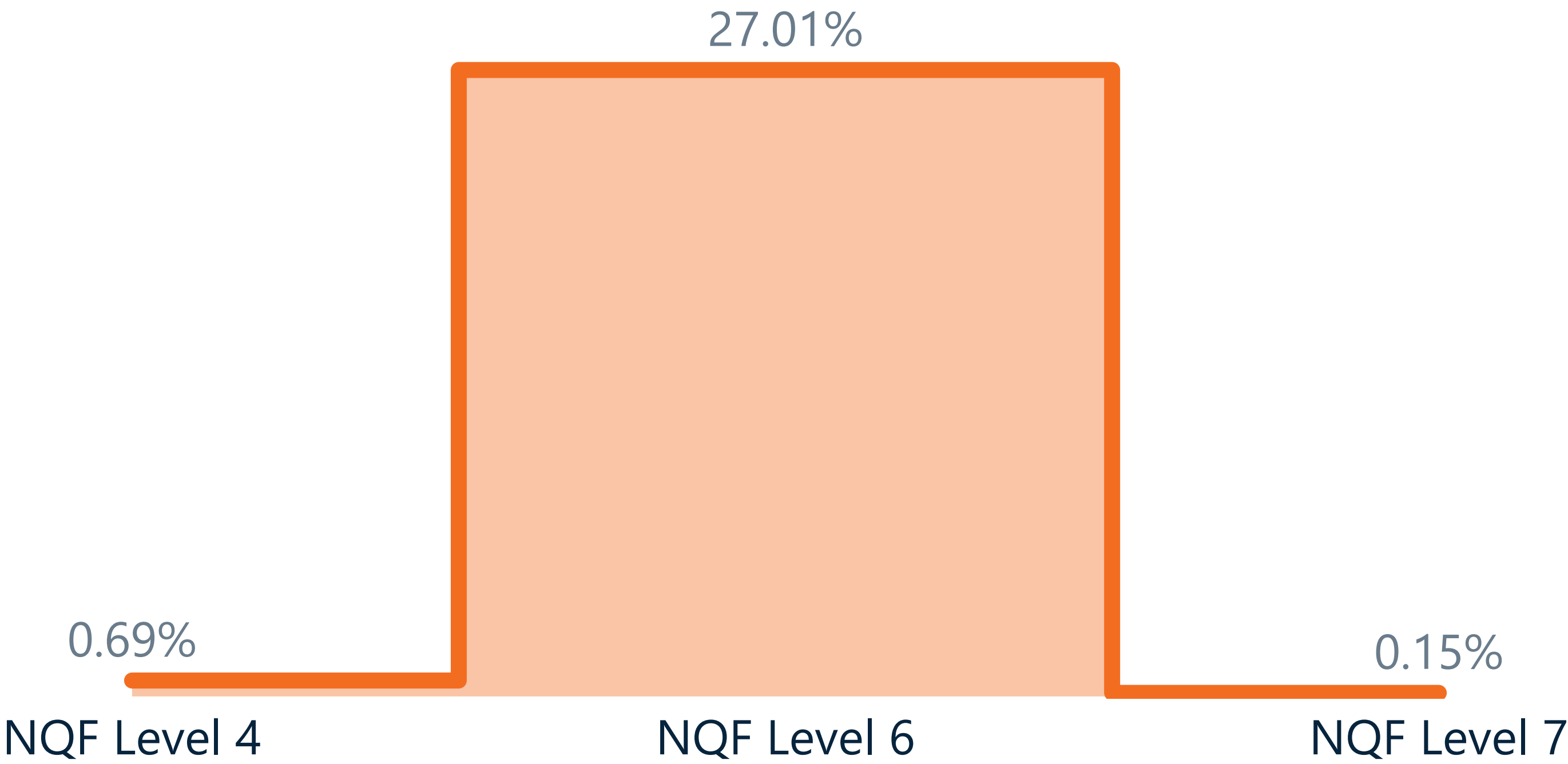


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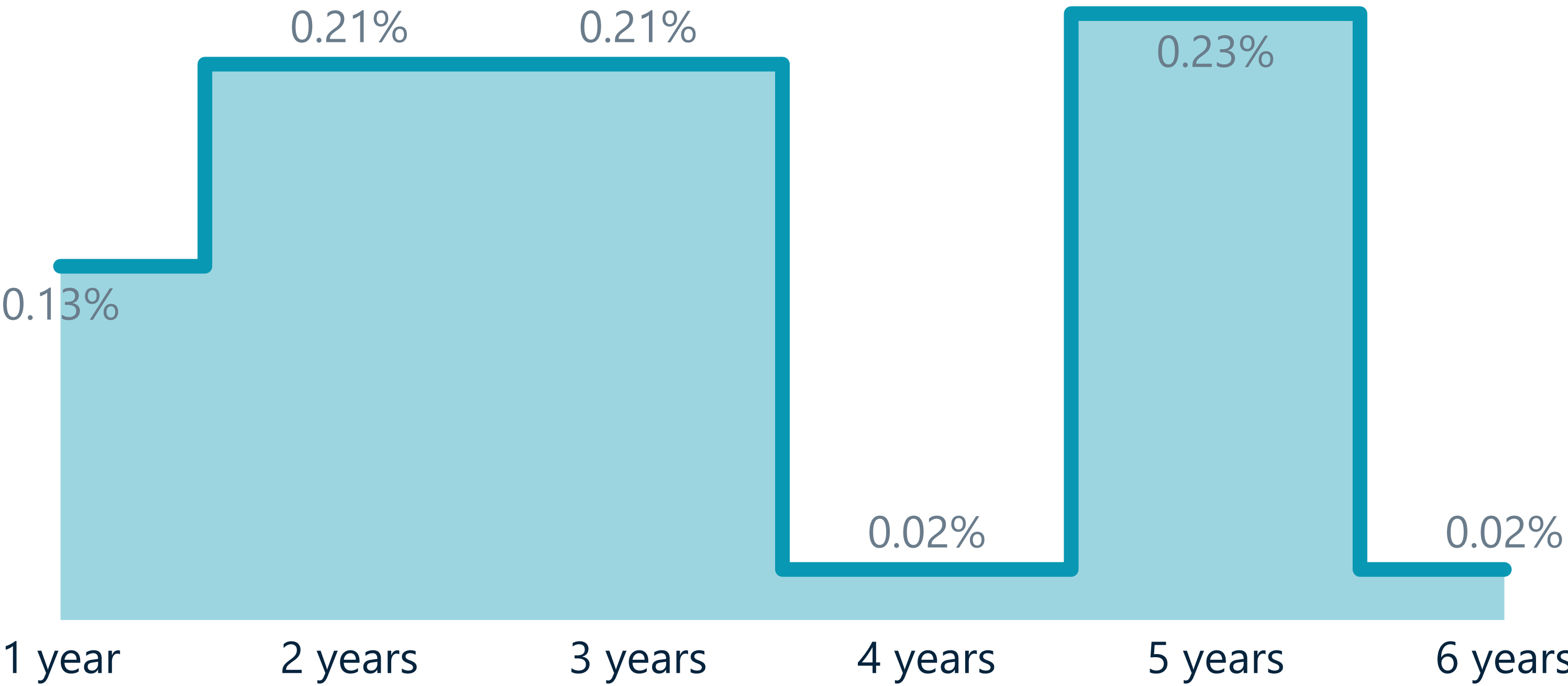
Top 5 Minimum Qualification Level

Writing	
Communicating effectively in writing as appropriate for the needs of the audience.	1
Time Management	
Managing one's own time and the time of others.	2
Complex Problem Solving	
Identifying complex problems and reviewing related information to develop and evaluate options and implement solutions.	3
Social Perceptiveness	
Being aware of others' reactions and understanding why they react as they do.	3
Speaking	
Talking to others to convey information effectively.	3



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Top 5 Required Knowledge

Customer and Personal Service	
Principles and processes for providing customer and personal services. This includes customer needs assessment, meeting quality standards for services, and evaluation of customer satisfaction.	1
Education and Training	
Principles and methods for curriculum and training design, teaching and instruction for individuals and groups, and the measurement of training effects.	2
Computers and Electronics	
Circuit boards, processors, chips, electronic equipment, and computer hardware and software, including applications and programming.	3
Administrative	
Administrative and office procedures and systems such as word processing, managing files and records, stenography and transcription, designing forms, and workplace terminology.	4
Public Safety and Security	
Relevant equipment, policies, procedures, and strategies to promote effective local, state, or national security operations for the protection of people, data, property, and institutions.	5
