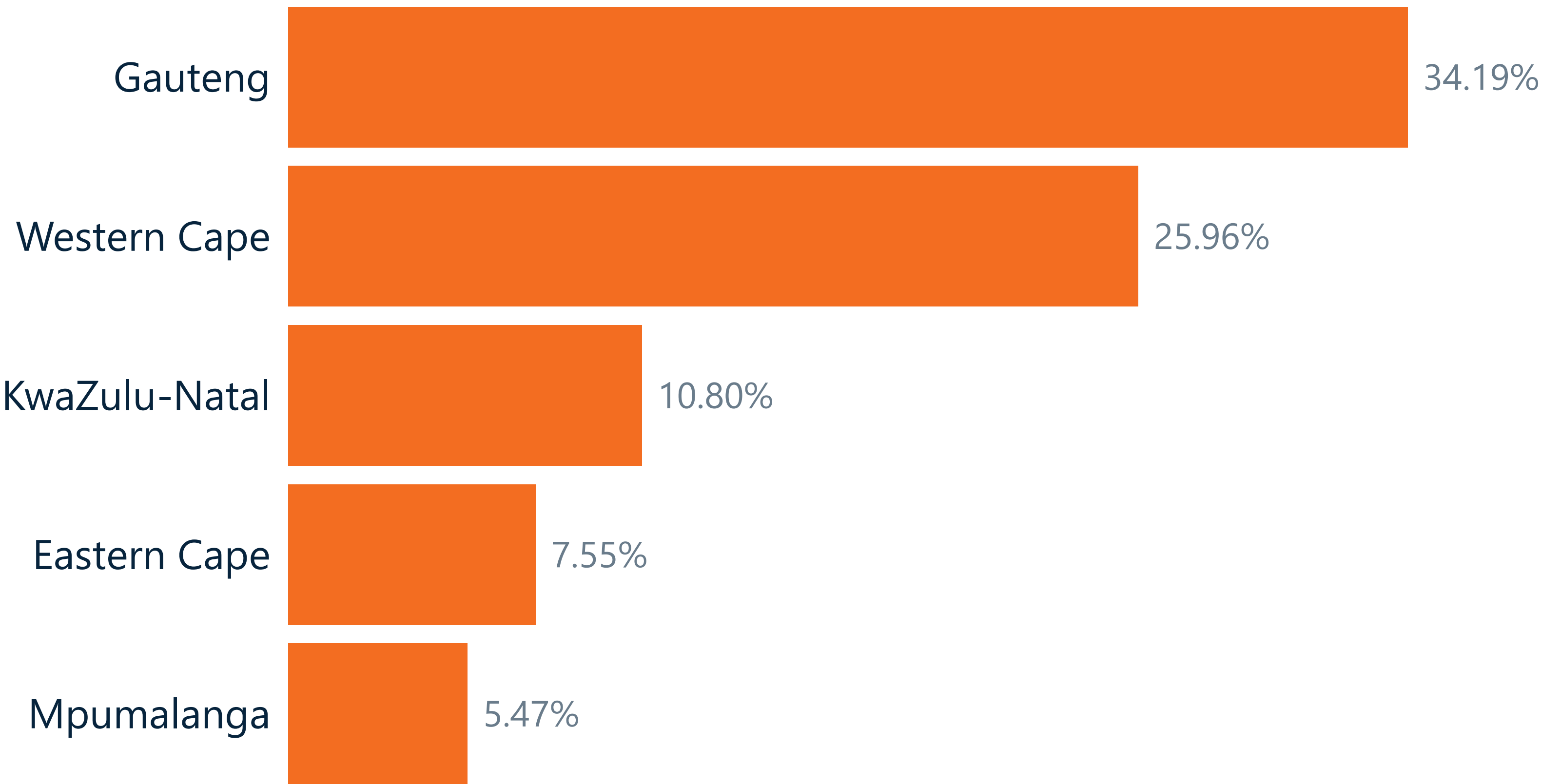

by percentage of job opportunities





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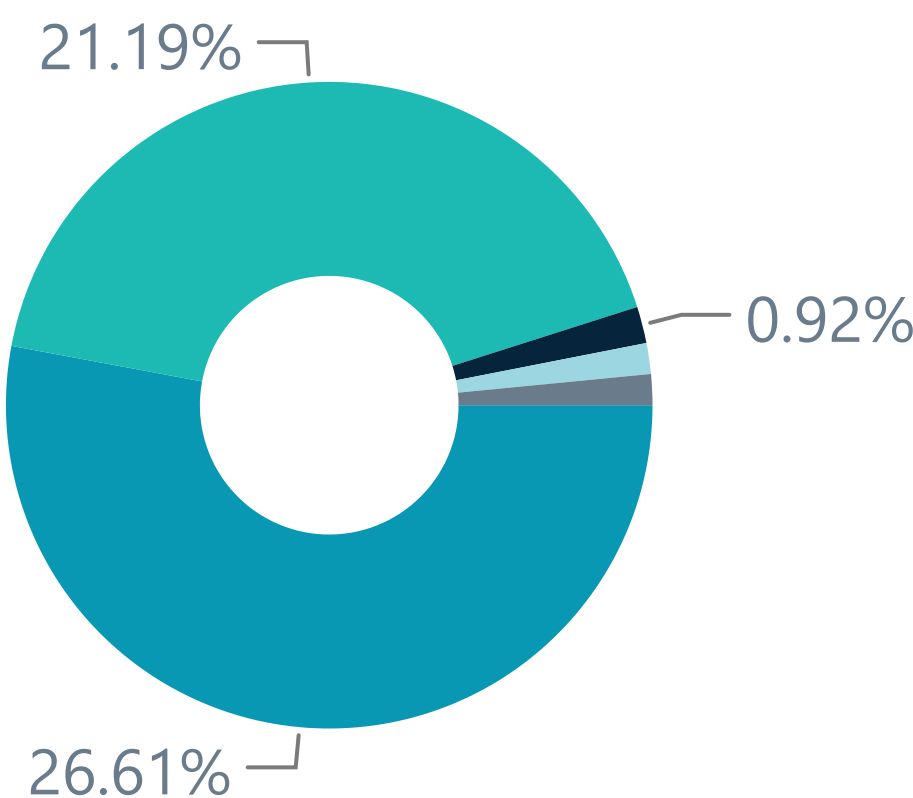

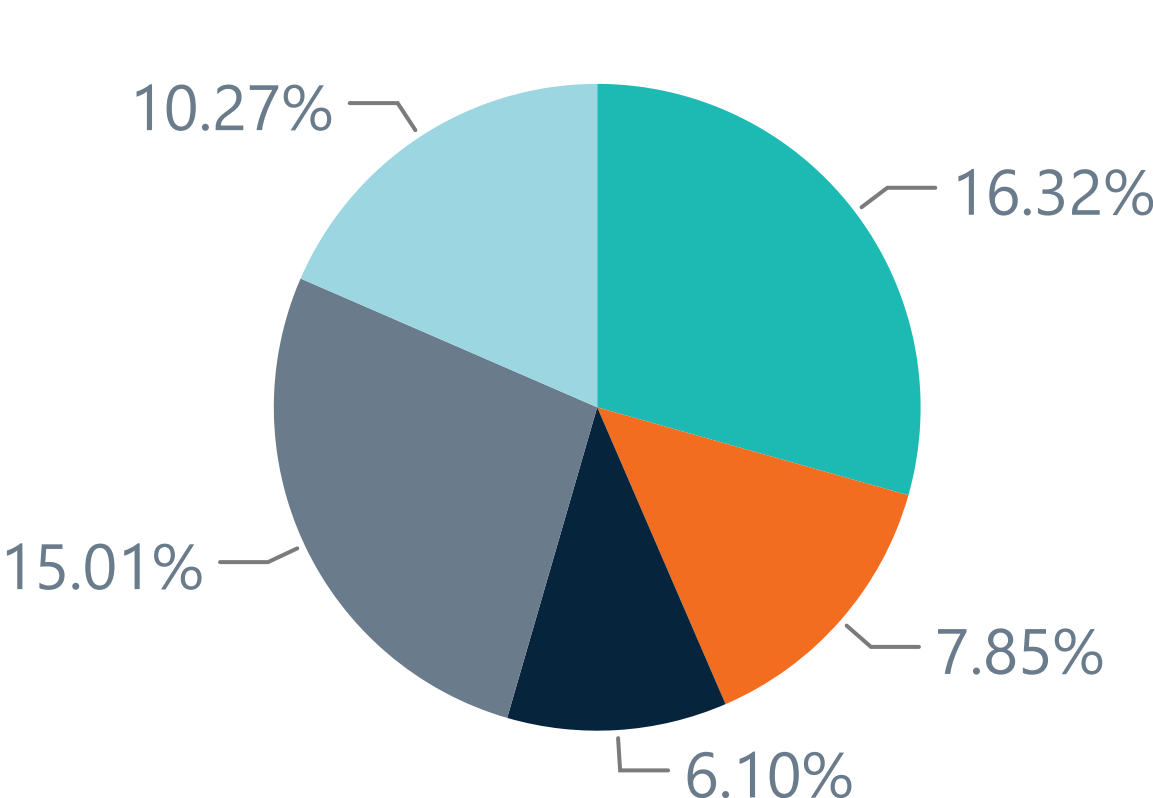

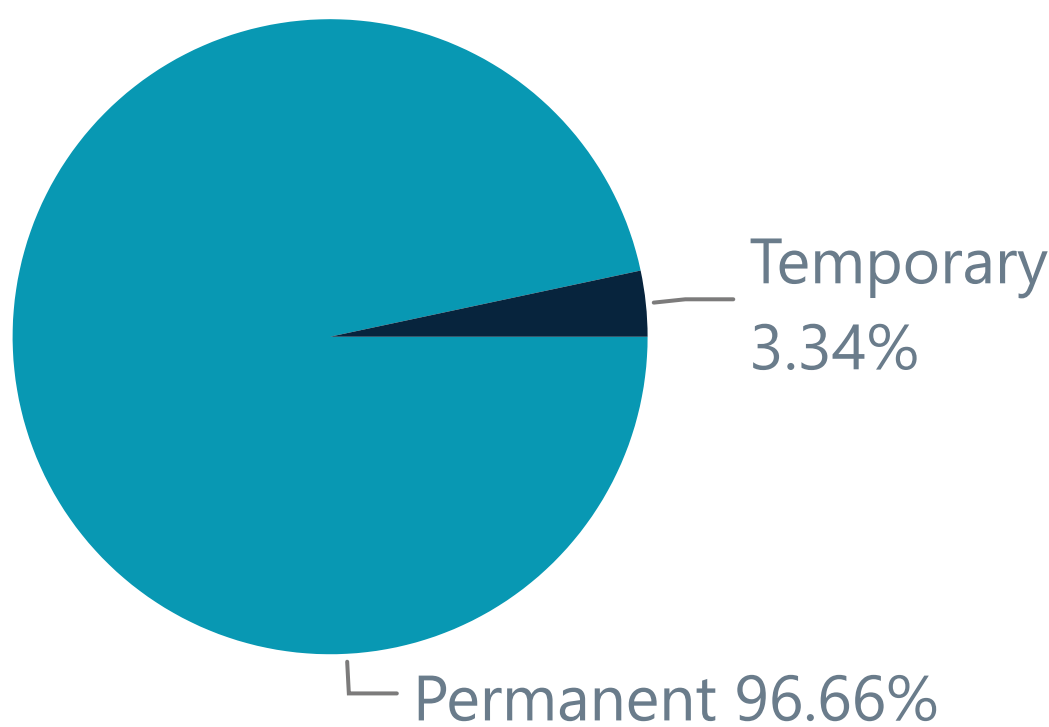

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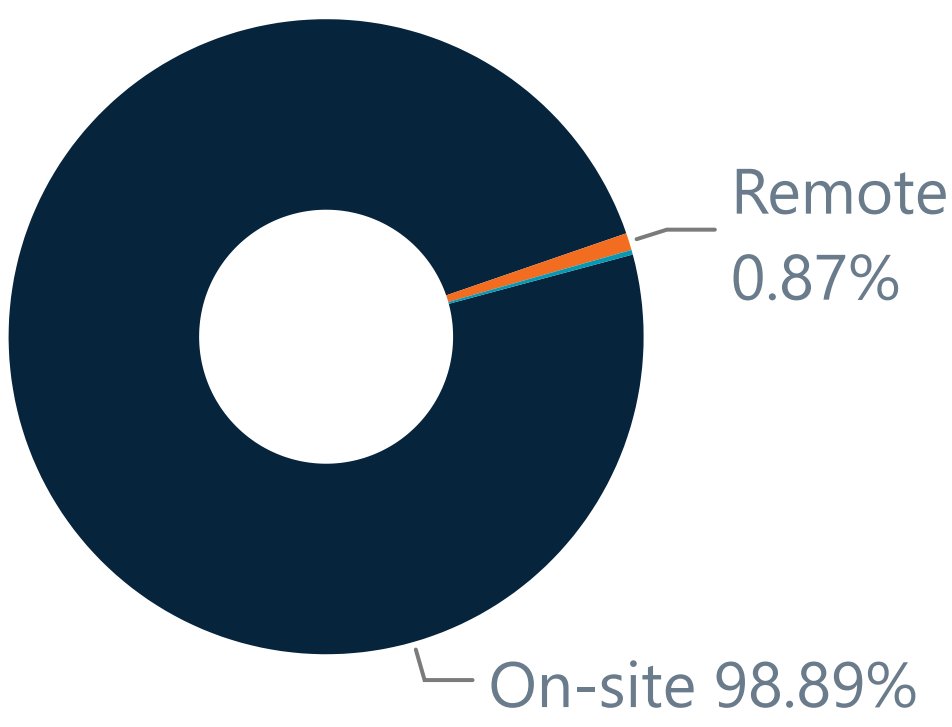
Employment Type

percentage of job opportunities



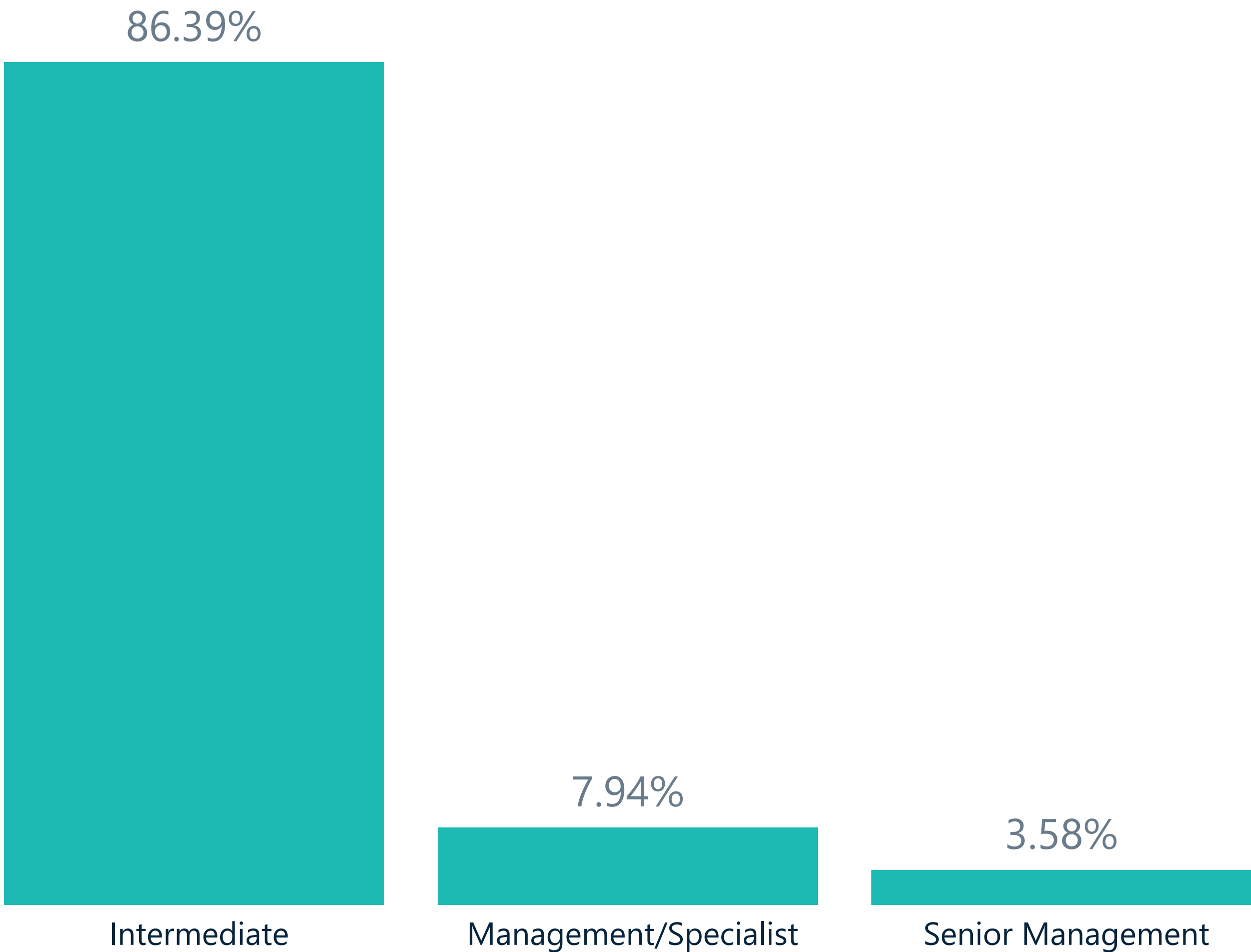
Employment Flexibility

by percentage of job opportunities



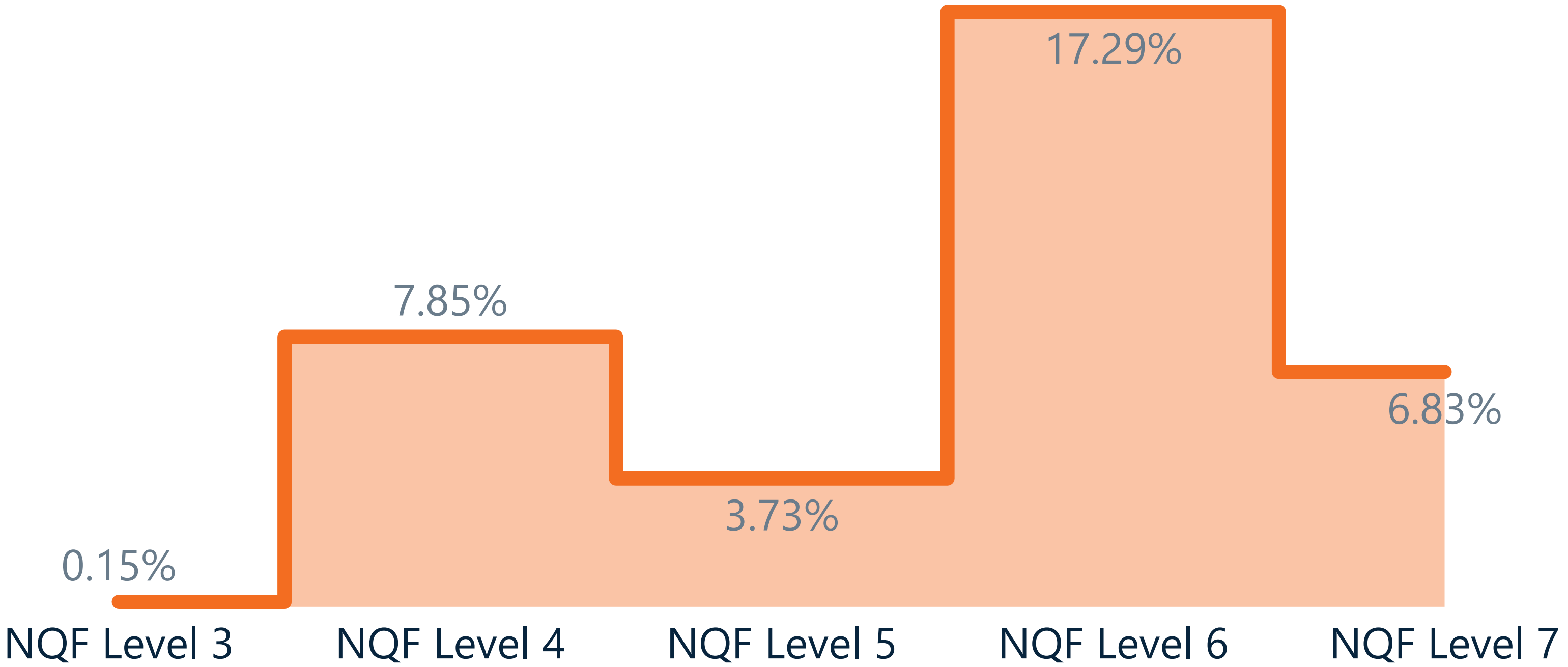


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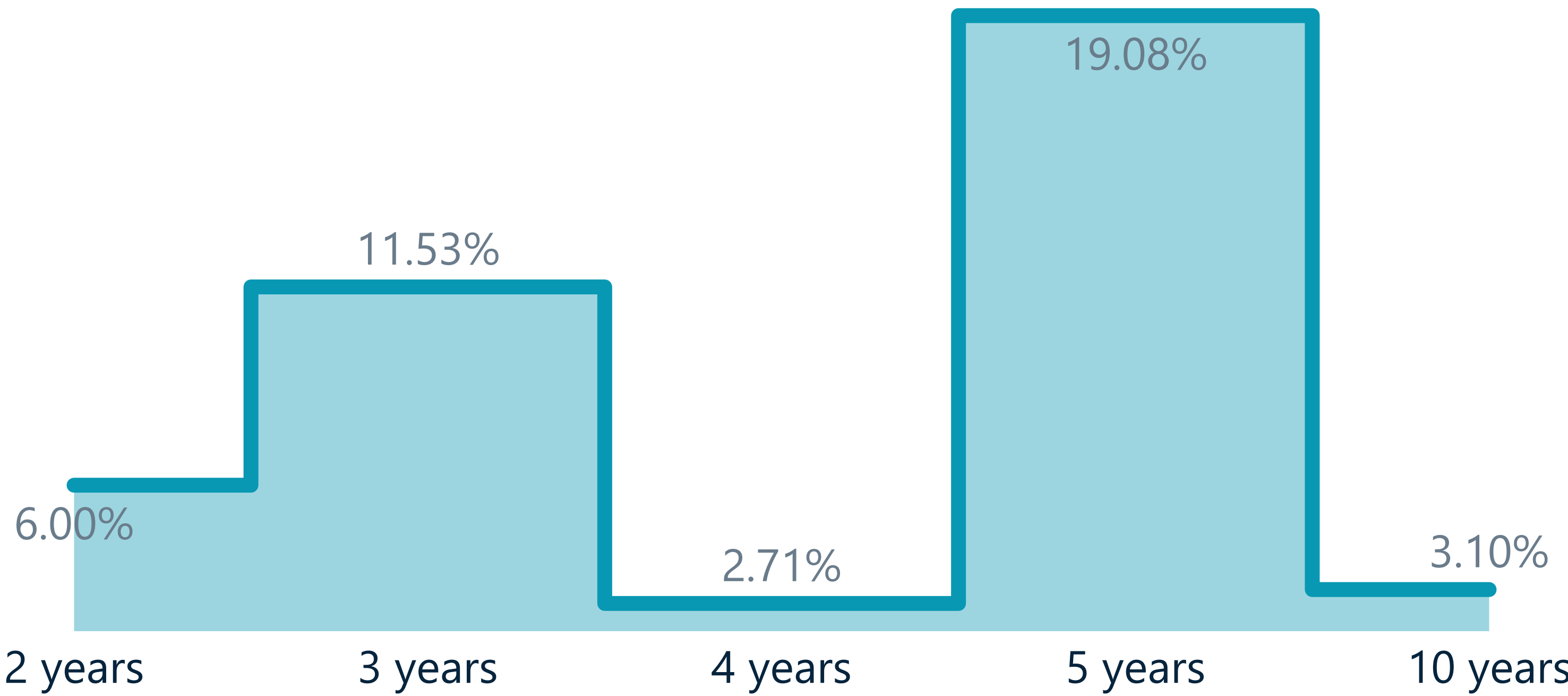
Top 5 Minimum Qualification Level

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Top 10 Required Skills

Equipment Maintenance	
Performing routine maintenance on equipment and determining when and what kind of maintenance is needed.	1
Time Management	
Managing one's own time and the time of others.	2
Quality Control Analysis	
Conducting tests and inspections of products, services, or processes to evaluate quality or performance.	3
Service Orientation	
Actively looking for ways to help people.	4
Equipment Selection	
Determining the kind of tools and equipment needed to do a job.	5
Systems Analysis	
Determining how a system should work and how changes in conditions, operations, and the environment will affect outcomes.	6
Repairing	
Repairing machines or systems using the needed tools.	7
Operations Monitoring	
Watching gauges, dials, or other indicators to make sure a machine is working properly.	8
Writing	
Communicating effectively in writing as appropriate for the needs of the audience.	9
Complex Problem Solving	
Identifying complex problems and reviewing related information to develop and evaluate options and implement solutions.	10



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Top 5 Required Knowledge

Administration and Management	
Business and management principles involved in strategic planning, resource allocation, human resources modeling, leadership technique, production methods, and coordination of people and resources.	1
Customer and Personal Service	
Principles and processes for providing customer and personal services. This includes customer needs assessment, meeting quality standards for services, and evaluation of customer satisfaction.	2
Public Safety and Security	
Relevant equipment, policies, procedures, and strategies to promote effective local, state, or national security operations for the protection of people, data, property, and institutions.	3
Mechanical	
Machines and tools, including their designs, uses, repair, and maintenance.	4
Engineering and Technology	
The practical application of engineering science and technology. This includes applying principles, techniques, procedures, and equipment to the design and production of various goods and services.	5
