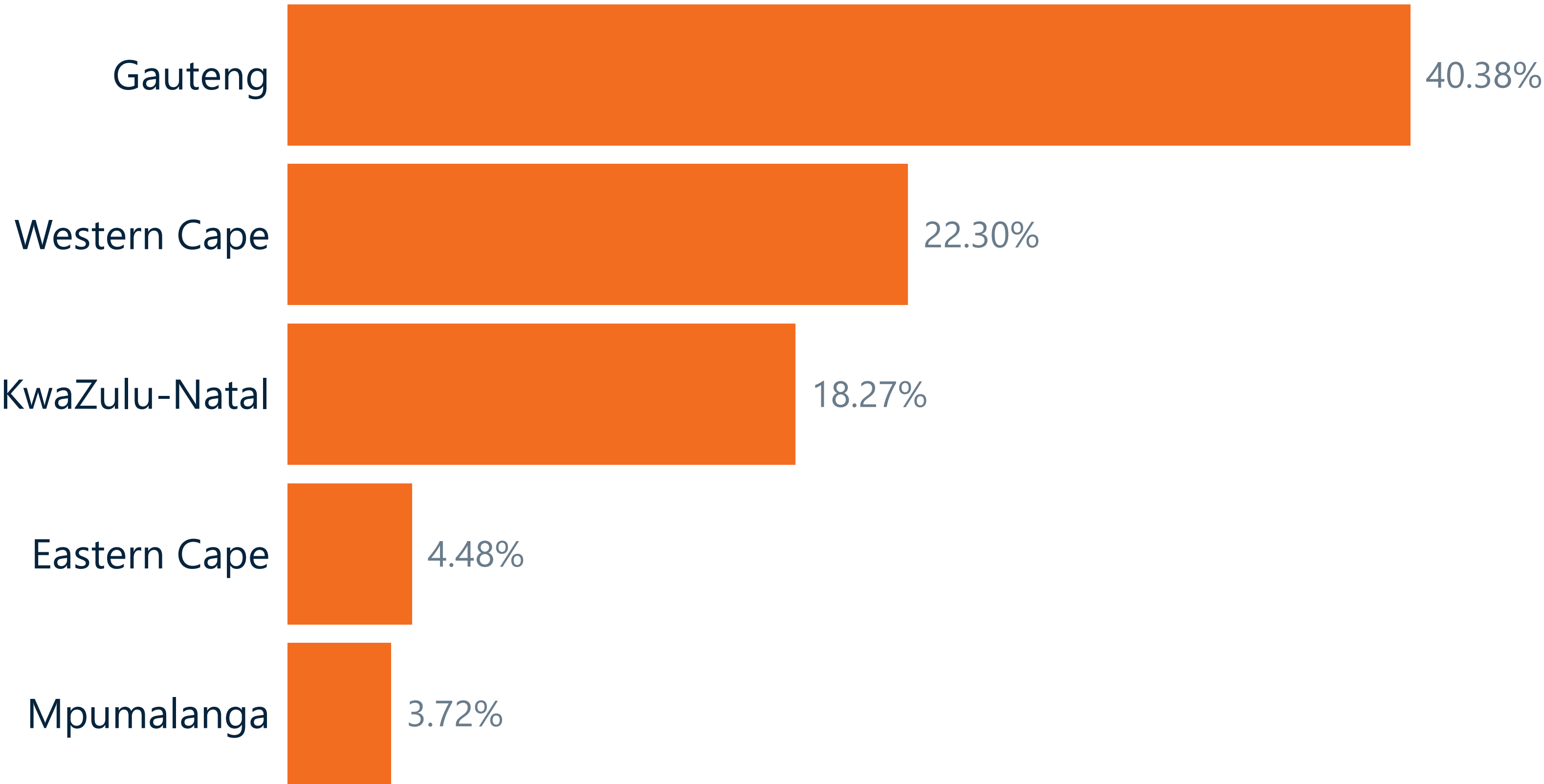

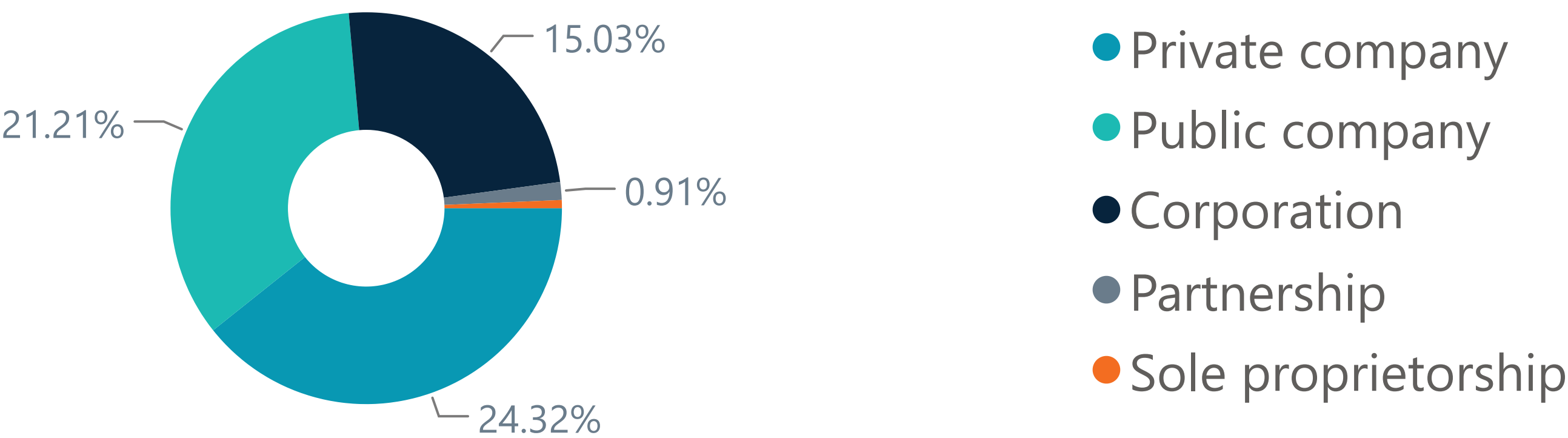

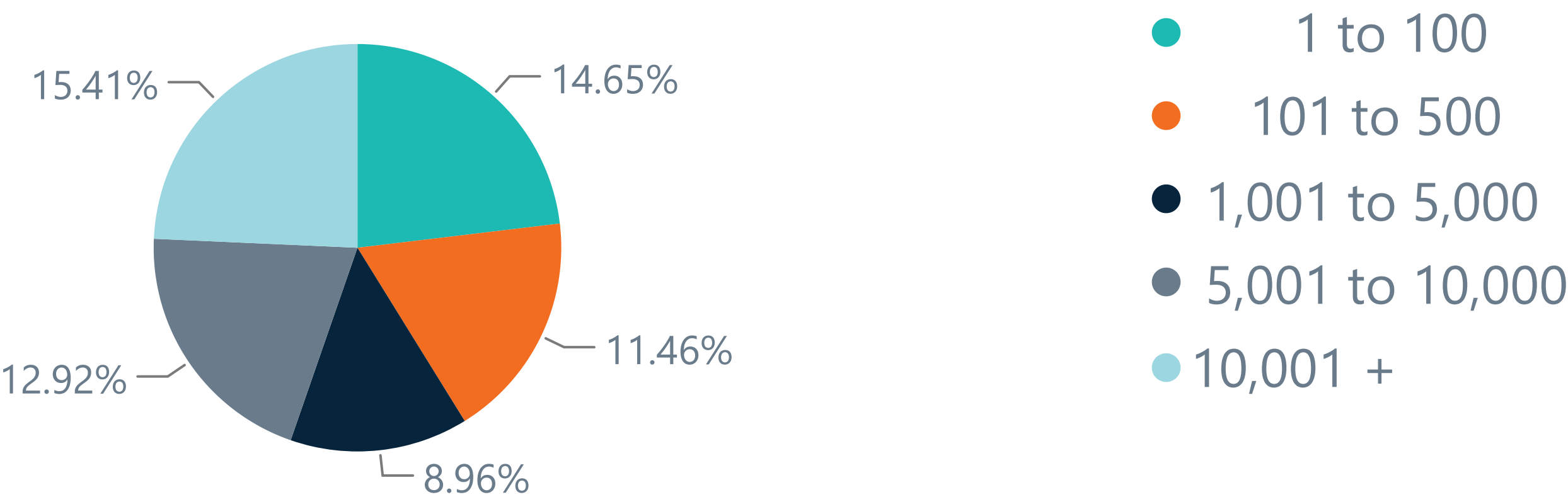
Top 5 Company Types

Top 5 Company Sizes

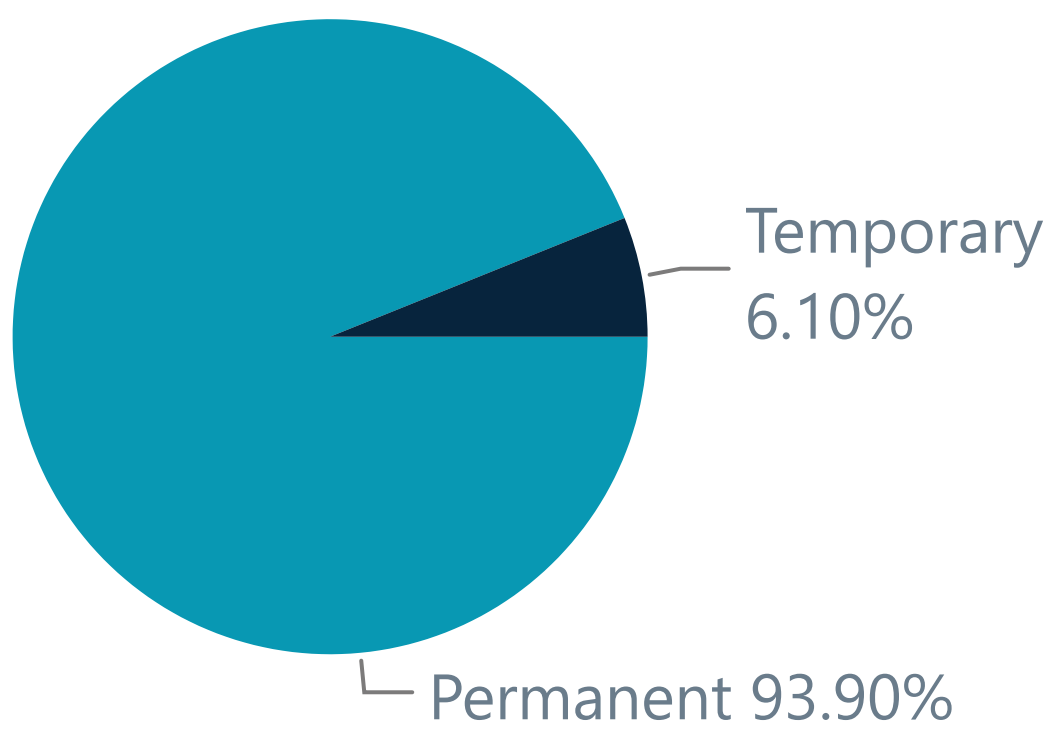

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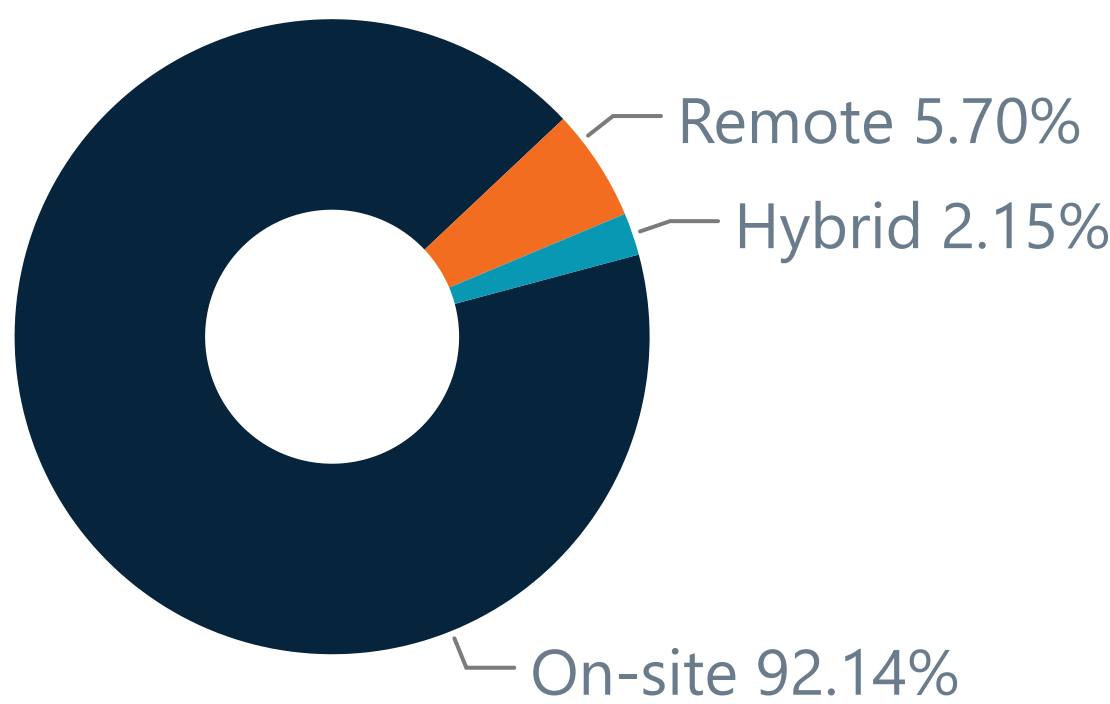
Employment Type

percentage of job opportunities



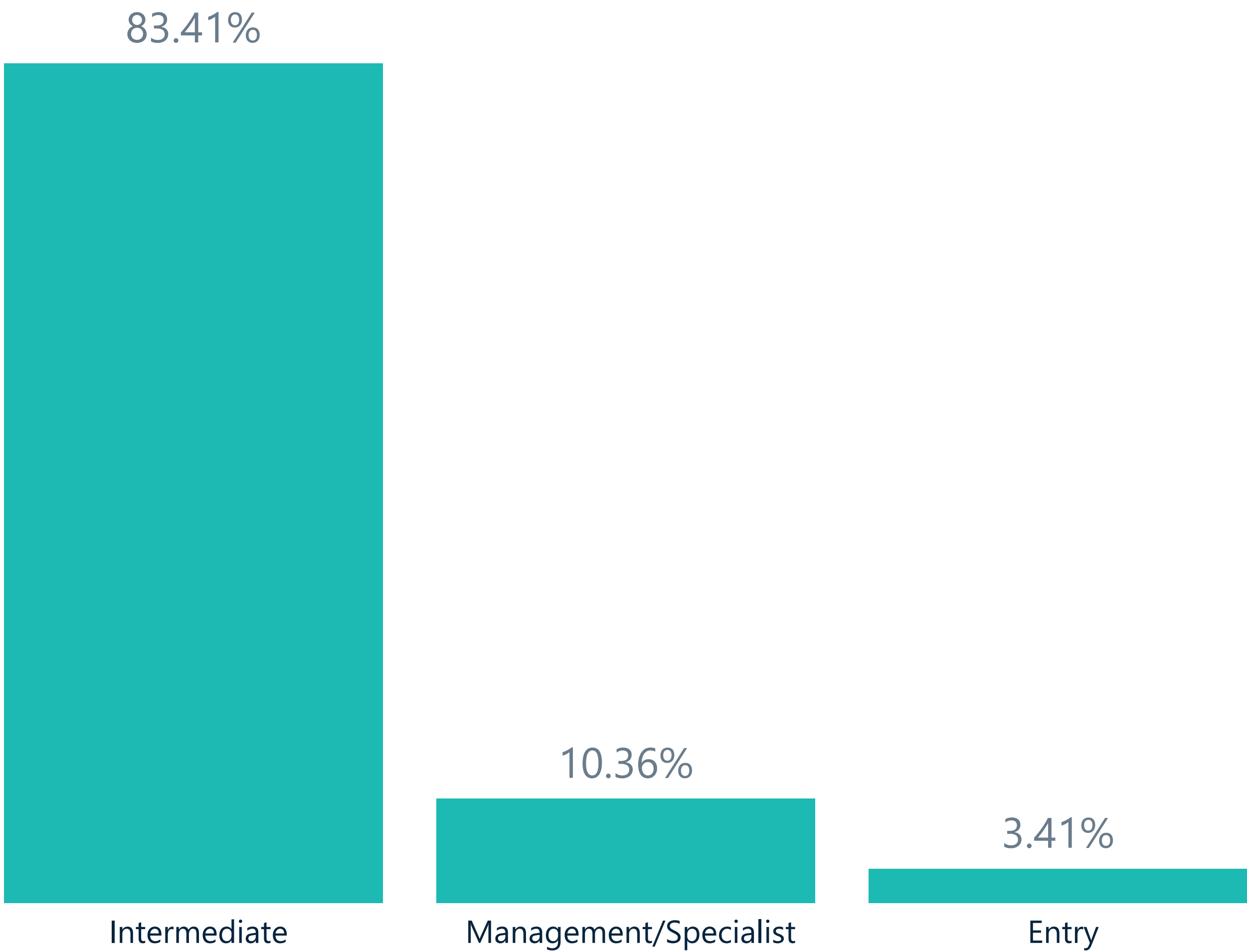
Employment Flexibility

by percentage of job opportunities

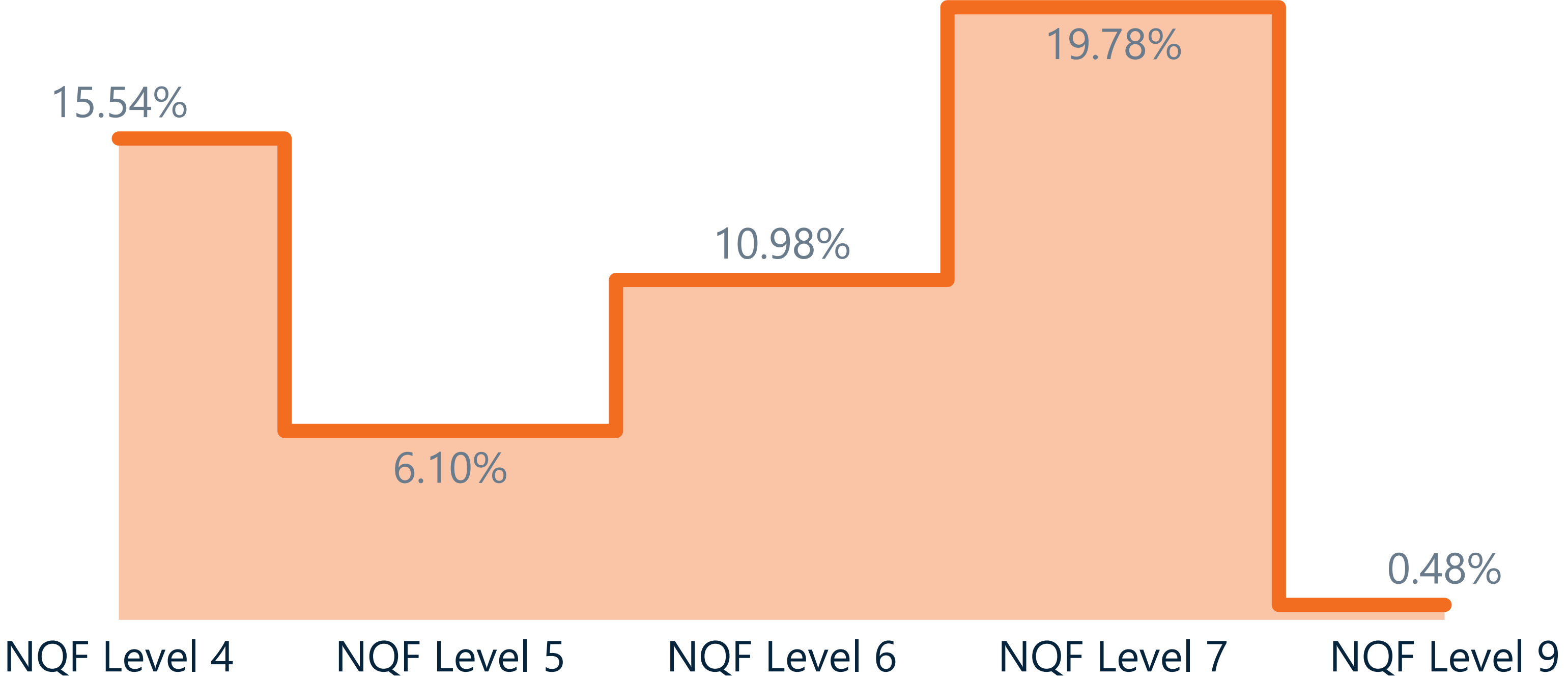




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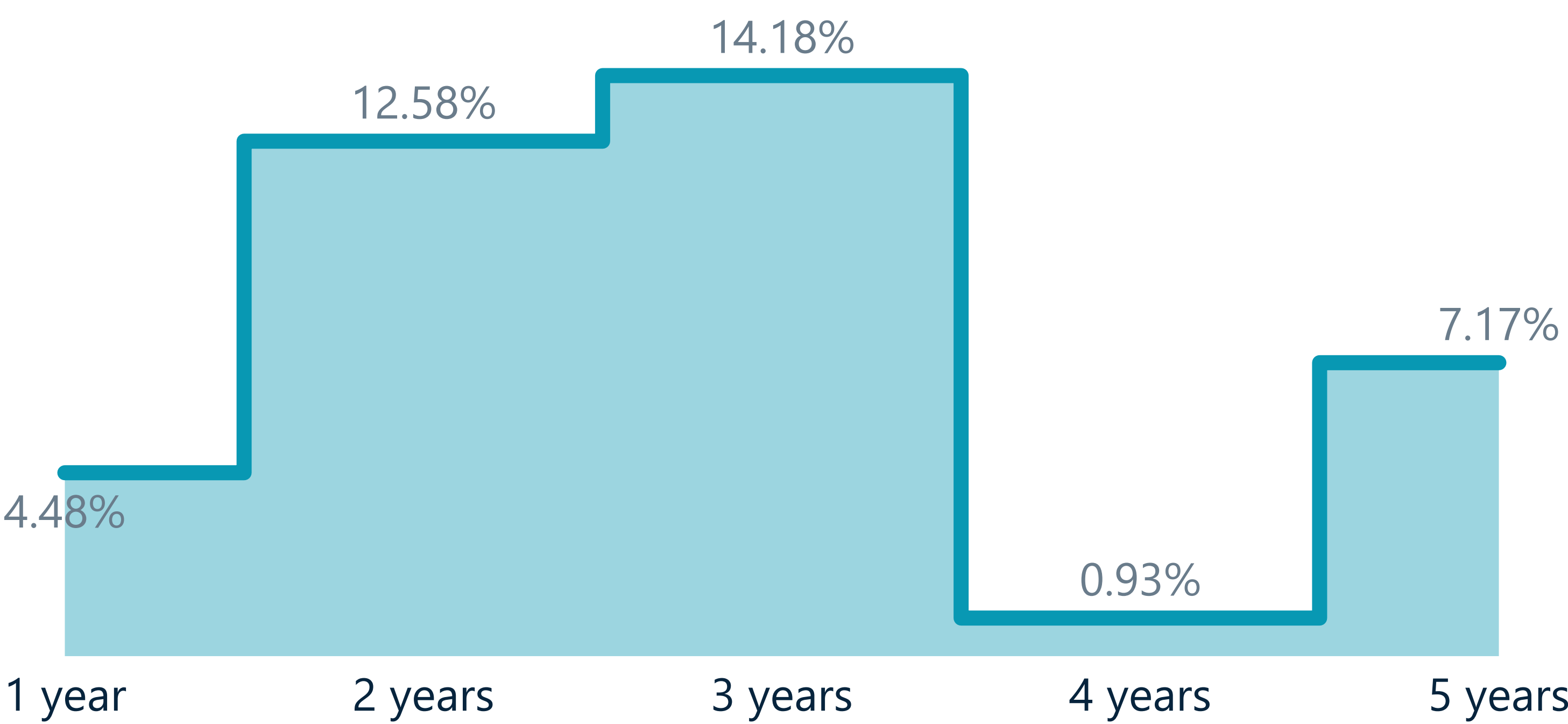
Top 5 Minimum Qualification Level

Service Orientation	
Actively looking for ways to help people.	1
Time Management	
Managing one's own time and the time of others.	2
Writing	
Communicating effectively in writing as appropriate for the needs of the audience.	2
Systems Analysis	
Determining how a system should work and how changes in conditions, operations, and the environment will affect outcomes.	4
Learning Strategies	
Selecting and using training/instructional methods and procedures appropriate for the situation when learning or teaching new things.	5
Social Perceptiveness	
Being aware of others' reactions and understanding why they react as they do.	6
Complex Problem Solving	
Identifying complex problems and reviewing related information to develop and evaluate options and implement solutions.	7
Operations Analysis	
Analyzing needs and product requirements to create a design.	8
Management of Financial Resources	
Determining how money will be spent to get the work done, and accounting for these expenditures.	9
Negotiation	
Bringing others together and trying to reconcile differences.	10



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Top 5 Required Knowledge

Customer and Personal Service	
Principles and processes for providing customer and personal services. This includes customer needs assessment, meeting quality standards for services, and evaluation of customer satisfaction.	1
Sales and Marketing	
Principles and methods for showing, promoting, and selling products or services. This includes marketing strategy and tactics, product demonstration, sales techniques, and sales control systems.	2
Administration and Management	
Business and management principles involved in strategic planning, resource allocation, human resources modeling, leadership technique, production methods, and coordination of people and resources.	3
Education and Training	
Principles and methods for curriculum and training design, teaching and instruction for individuals and groups, and the measurement of training effects.	4
Personnel and Human Resources	
Principles and procedures for personnel recruitment, selection, training, compensation and benefits, labor relations and negotiation, and personnel information systems.	5
